TIPS FOR SUCCESSFUL EMBROIDERY!



Keep these pages accessible, you will need to refer to these "Tips" throughout your embroidery!! Follow Claudia's two step "**Perfect Placement Technique**" for accurately multi-hooping large designs!

Step #1: Marking the design's first stitch location on the grid:

- Attach the hoop and grid to the module with no fabric.
- Open the design to be embroidered.
- Advance to the embroidery sewing screen. Embroidery Machines open a design in an editing screen. Touch the
 icon that moves you to the embroidery sewing screen. Advancing to the embroidery sewing screen takes you to
 the first stitch of the design, where you are ready to embroider!

Brother, Babylock & Janome machines have an automatic center stitch programmed into the machine. You must advance past this "programmed center stitch" to move to the first stitch of my designs. These machines will have an additional icon (usually a +/- key) you will need to touch to move you to first stitch of my design.

The **Basting Box option** must be **turned off** before advancing to the embroidery sewing screen.

- When at first stitch: by hand, lower your needle to touch the grid. Place an arrow shaped post-it-note on the grid so the tip of the arrow touches the tip of the needle. This marks the first stitch location of my design on the grid (not the center of the design, not the center of the hoop, but the first stitch of the opened design).
- Raise the needle; remove the hoop and the marked grid from the module.

Step #2: Hooping the Fabric

- Place the inner hoop with the grid on the (stabilized and marked) background fabric. The arrow shaped post-itnote on the grid should be pointing to either the Needle Alignment or to the Placement Line location on the background fabric. The location is noted in the Embroidery Instructions and will be different for each hooping (it will
 almost never be the center of the hoop).
- Hoop the (stabilized and marked) fabric with the lines on the grid parallel and perpendicular to the drawn lines on the fabric. The drawn lines need not lie exactly under the lines of the grid, but must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid. This keeps the larger piece of fabric square and straight as you embroider.
- Remove the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module.
- It may be necessary to re-position the needle exactly over the **mark** indicated in the instructions. Use your **Move Motif Icon** to tweak the needle perfectly over the mark.
- Needle Alignment is to place the needle over a specific mark like the drawn crosshair on the fabric
- Placement Line is to sew (without thread) over previously sewn stitches to ensure correct placement.

Additional Tips and Helps!

Tip #1: Built in Basting Box!

Many embroidery machines have a built-in basting box option. When this option is enabled it may add a color stop to the stitching order of the design. This option should be disabled before opening a design. If the basting box option is on or enabled when you advance to the embroidery sewing screen, you would be marking the grid with the first stitch position for the basting box and not the first stitch of the design!

Be sure to disable the basting box option before opening a design. Mark the first stitch of the design with the post-it note arrow.

Tip #2: Hooping Tips



Place sections of **permanent** double sided tape **(not repositionable)** on the wrong side of the inner hoop. Then flip the inner hoop right side up and place the inner hoop, with the grid inside of it, on the fabric.

The doubled sided tape holds the inner hoop to the fabric. This makes it easier to pick up the inner hoop and fabric and place it in the outer hoop with ease. (Always loosen the outer hoop screws as much as possible).

Remove the tear away stabilizer from the last hooping to reduce the stabilizer "bulk".

Roll the excess fabric in a tube shape and use clips to hold the excess fabric out of the way.

Tip #3: Unusual Embroidery Instructions:

Needle Alignment: This is placed first in the stitching order to align the needle exactly where it goes. It is strictly for needle placement and not to be sewn out (unless indicated). If it is accidently sewn out it will look like a crosshair. Pick it out!

Placement Line: This is a line that is to be sewn **out without thread** over an existing line to ensure correct placement. It is an alignment tool for connecting one hooping to another.

The blank line after the thread color: Thread Purple #_____ (Write your thread Color # on the line) It will help you remember what color you used when you return to embroidering.

Tip #4: Babylock & Brother Machines

Sometimes these machines like to rotate the design.

Don't know why!! Make sure the design on YOUR screen has the same orientation as the picture on the instructions. This is a reminder!!-

Babylock & Brother machines may need to rotate the design to look like this!

Tip #5: Trimming the Blocks

For best accuracy, use a **square ruler** to trim all the blocks. Place the square ruler on the block lining up two sides, then trim. Trimming with a 6" x 24" ruler is **not as accurate** and leads to slips and miss-cuts. If you have difficulty keeping a ruler from moving when you cut, wear quilting gloves to help hold it in place!

Tip #6 Sewing without Thread

Every machine has a icon where you can advance or move backwards through a design. This is usually used when you "break a needle" or "run out of bobbin thread" and you need to backup to replace stitches. I use this icon to advance through a design to "sew without thread." As you advance lower & raise the needle often to check the position to be sure you are correctly following the placement line.

Fabric Preparation

Terial Magic.

Saturate the background fabric in **Terial Magic.** Spray or pour onto the fabric to saturate. This product is a heavy starch. The fabric must be very stiff to avoid stretching during embroidery. Let the fabric almost dry then iron the fabric flat and smooth. (YouTube channel / claudiascreationsaz)

Woven Interfacing:

Place the woven interfacing (Shape Flex 101 by Pellon) adhesive side down, on the wrong side of the fabric. Spray with water to activate the adhesive. Use your hands to smooth out the moistened Interfacing over the fabric before using the steam iron. Set the steam iron on the center area and hold the iron long enough to dry & seal the two layers together, but not so long that it burns! Pick up the iron and place it close to the first spot. Repeat until all the interfacing is sealed to the fabric. This will "pre-shrink" both fabric and interfacing. The Interfacing will shrink, that is expected. All the edges of the Interfacing should be sealed to the fabric as if they were one piece so they can't be separated. To cover larger pieces of fabric, continue the process by overlapping the pieced sections by ½".

Fabric Preparation for All Blocks & Borders

Terial Magic.

Saturate the background fabric (shown above) in **Terial Magic.** Spray or pour onto the fabric to saturate. This product is a heavy starch. The fabric must be very stiff to avoid stretching during embroidery. Let the fabric almost dry then iron the fabric flat and smooth. (YouTube channel / claudiascreationsaz Terial Magic)

Interfacing: Shape Flex 101 by Pellon

Center and Iron interfacing (after Terial Magic) to the back of the Background Fabric. Piece the interfacing to get the size needed. Over lap the pieced sections by ½". The interfacing may be slightly smaller than the fabric blocks & it will shrink when you iron it. Lightly spray with water to activate the adhesive. Smooth the interfacing with your hands (this will help to displace the air between the interfacing & fabric).

Start pressing in the center and work out slowly. Iron with steam, the interfacing to the fabric. All edges should be sealed together. If you see air bubbles, spray with water and iron again. Watch my Fabric Prep video for a demo.

Background Fabric: (3 ½ yards)

Cut (3) 20" x 44"+/- (or width of Fabric) Strips

Set (1) aside 20" x 44"+/- strip this is the Center Block

Sub Cut the (2) remaining strips in half:"

Marking the Fabric:



Mark on the front side of the fabric (with removable marker):

a horizontal & vertical line, centered on the fabric block/strip. (aka=Center Crosshair)



Read all before marking:

Place the upper right corner of the square ruler in the center of the fabric. See diagram. Draw a line across the top and down the right side of the ruler. This gives you a perfect 90° angle. Extend lines from there. Add all lines needed.



Select the prepared Background Fabric block with additional lines. Select folder with the format your machine reads. Attach the hoop and the grid (no fabric) to the module.

Open #1 Sled (or Open Combo Folder see pages 95-96)

Step #1 Advance to the embroidery sewing screen to go to the 1st stitch of the design.

Step #2 Lower the needle, lay an arrow shaped post it note on the grid with the tip of the arrow touching the needle. (The arrow is positioned about 2" to the LEFT & just ABOVE center on the grid).

Fabric Position: To hoop this design position the Top of the Fabric is at the top of the hoop. See Example #1 below for 1st stitch position.



Hoop the fabric with the **arrow on the grid pointing 2**" to the RIGHT of the Center Crosshair on the FABRIC. See **Example #1**. The drawn lines on the fabric must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid.


Remove the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module. Float stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop.


No Thread, Color #1 **Placement Line.** The needle is positioned **2" to the RIGHT** of the Center Crosshair **on the fabric**. See green start arrow in **Example #1.** Sew Color #1 without thread.

How to sew without thread: use the Broken Thread or Advance Stitch icon!! See Tips for Successful Embroidery.

It sews from the start arrow, to the right following the drawn line, to the end arrow. Reposition if needed to follow the line. Add a basting box, sew it out & then turn it off. Advance to **Color #2.**

Embroider the tree, box, & light bulb.
Thread Color #3 Muslin (0870) #
Embroider the snowman and snow on boxes.
Thread Color #4 Caribbean Blue (4010) #
Embroider the boxes, light bulb, & knit hat.
Thread Color #5 Wildfire (1800) #
Embroider the scarf, sled and trim on boxes.
Thread Color #6 Candlelight (0811) #
Embroider the light bulb, inside of box and box handles.
Thread Color #7 Bright Mint (5610) #
Embroider the left tree and hat.
Thread Color #8 Very Berry (2721) #
Embroider the light bulb.
Thread Color #9 Yellowgreen (6043) #
Embroider the skinny tree.
Thread Color #10 Sterling (0142) #
Embroider tops of the light bulbs and squirrels.
Thread Color #11 Bright Green (5324) #
Embroider the shortest tree.
Thread Color #12 Nutmeg (0932) #
Embroider the arms, nut and squirrel tails.
Thread Color #13 Sterling (again) (0142) #
Embroider the highlights on the squirrels.
Thread Color #14 Red Pepper (1304) #
Embroider the nose and light bulb.
Thread Color #15 Nutmeg (again) (0932) #
Embroider the shading on the squirrel body.
Thread Color #16 Black (0020) #
Embroider the outlining, snowflakes & mountains.
Remove the hoop from the module and the fabric from the hoop
Gently remove the stabilizer & basting stitches from the back.

Top of the Fabric

Fabric Position: To hoop this design position the Top of the Fabric at the top of the hoop. See Example #2 below for 1st stitch position.





Hoop the fabric with the arrow on the grid pointing to the Crosshair 2" to the LEFT of Center on the fabric.


See Example #2. The drawn lines on the fabric must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid. Remove the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module.


Float tear away stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop, MANDATORY!

No Thread, Color #1 Placement Line. The needle is positioned 2" to the LEFT of Center on the fabric. See green start arrow in Example #2. Sew Color #1 without thread. It sews from the start arrow, to the left following the drawn line, to the end arrow. Reposition if needed. Add a basting box, sew it out then turn it off. Advance to Color #2.

Step #1 Advance to the embroidery sewing screen to go to the 1st stitch of the design.

Step #2 Lower the needle, lay an arrow shaped post it note on the grid with the tip of the arrow touching the needle. (The arrow is positioned about 2 1/4" to the RIGHT & slightly above center on the grid).

Top of the Fabric

Fabric Position: To hoop this design position the Top of the Fabric at the top of the hoop. See Example #3 below for 1st stitch position.

Hoop the fabric with the arrow on the grid pointing to the Center Crosshair on the fabric.

See Example #3. The drawn lines on the fabric must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid. Remove the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module.

Float tear away stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop, MANDATORY!


No Thread, Color #1 Placement Line. The needle is positioned over the Center Crosshair on the fabric. See green start arrow in Example #3. Sew Color #1 without thread. It sews from the start arrow, downward following the drawn line, to the end arrow. Reposition if needed to follow the line. Add a basting box, sew it out then turn it off. Advance to Color #2.




Step #1 Advance to the **embroidery sewing screen** to go to the 1st stitch of the design.

Step #2 Lower the needle, lay an arrow shaped post it note on the grid with the tip of the arrow touching the needle. (The arrow is positioned slightly to the LEFT and 2 ½" below center on the grid).

(Refer to "Tips for Successful Embroidery" about getting to the 1st stitch of the design for Brother, Babylock, & Janome macnines)

Fabric Position: To hoop this design the **Top of the Fabric** is **rotated to the RIGHT** of the hoop.

See Example #1 below for 1st stitch position.



Hoop the fabric with the arrow on the grid pointing to the Center Crosshair on the FABRIC.

See **Example #1**. The drawn lines on the fabric must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid.

Remove the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module.

Float tear away stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop, MANDATORY!

No Thread, Color #1 **Placement Line.** The needle is positioned over the Center Crosshair **on the fabric**. See green start arrow in **Example #1.** Sew Color #1 without thread.

How to sew without thread: use the Broken Thread or Advance Stitch icon!! See Tips for Successful Embroidery.

It sews from the start arrow, upward following the drawn line, to the end arrow. Reposition if needed to follow the line.

Add a basting box, sew it out, then turn it off.







Fabric Position: To hoop this design the Top of the Fabric is positioned at the top of the hoop.

Hoop the fabric with the arrow on the grid pointing to the Center Crosshair on the FABRIC.

See **Example #2**. The drawn lines on the fabric must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid.

Remove the grid, attach the hoop to the module. Float tear away stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop.

No Thread, Color #1 **Placement Line.** The needle is positioned over the Center Crosshair **on the fabric**. See green start arrow in **Example #2**. Sew Color #1 without thread.

How to sew without thread: use the Broken Thread or Advance Stitch icon!! See Tips for Successful Embroidery #6 page #4.



finished size 16" x 8" **Tree Trimming & Sledding:** Cut Block: 16.5" x 8.5" Snow Angel Block & Smores : Cut Block: 13" x 8.5" finished size 12.5" x 8"

Make sure the vertical & horizonal lines on the ruler are parallel & perpendicular with the lines

Cutting the Sashing

Before cutting the fabric, back the fabric with Shape Flex 101 interfacing by Pellon. This will give the Sashing the same weight and texture as the rest of the Quilt top. Sashing Fabric: (1/2 yard)

Cut (6) 2" Strips by Width of Fabric 44"+/-


Sub Cut (1) 2" Strip into:

(1) 2" x 81/2" Strip for Top Row Sashing

(1) 2" x 9½ Strip for **Bottom Row** Sashing

Cut (1) 3" Strip by Width of Fabric 44"+/-

(3" Strip is the Sashing below the Center Block: this strip will have the words)



Piecing the Center

Use scant quarter inch seams. Follow the diagram for placement. Measure each individual border after you sew the sashing & blocks together.

- 1. Piece the Top Row: Measures 30½" wide x 8½" high.
- 2. Piece the Center Row: Measures 30½" wide x 13½" high.


The Center section must be 131/2" high. If it is not, trim the raw edge of the wider sashing so the section height measures 131/2" high.


- 3. Piece the Bottom Row: Measures 30½" wide x 9½" high.
- 4. Sew the Left & Right Side sashings to the Center.

Must measure 33½" wide x 30½" high.

Measure across the top, center & bottom of the Quilt Top to make sure measurements are the same.

5. Sew the Top & Bottom sashings to the Center.





(See next page for Layout)

Must measure 33½" square. Measure across the Quilt top, center & bottom vertically & horizontally to make sure it is square. If if is not, you need to adjust the seams to get it square.

This is the only way the railroad corners will fit!!

Outer Sashing:

The Outer Sashing 1.75" (1 3/4") has one unfinished edge.

When assembled, mark the Center of all (4) Outer Sashing Strips

When it is sewn to all 4 of the Embroidered Borders, the sashing will finish at 1.5" (11/2) wide.

Inner Sashing:

The Inner Sashing's finish at 1.5" (11/2) wide.

The Center Sashing:

The Center Sashing finishes at 2.5" (21/2") wide.





Fabric Preparation for Words

Mark the Fabric:

Mark a Center Crosshair on the 2 ½" wide Border. This is the Sashing strip under the Sleigh Ride Block.

Make sure it is the full width and height of the Border.

Definitely make sure the lines you draw are parallel and perpendicular to your seams lines.

This will make the words parallel to the seams lines and look perfectly straight. See the red Crosshair above in the picture.

Bobbin Thread:

Fill a bobbin with the same color thread you plan to use for the Words. This will ensure that the lettering will look great!

Drawn Line & Cut Line

- Draw a straight line on the INNER EDGE side, 1" below the train track & wheels.
- The Inner Edge has the train track closest to the edge. See **Drawn Line** green arrow.
- Place two or more straight edge rulers together (short ends) to get at least 48". (i.e. 6"x24") This will give you a perfectly straight line to work with. Extend the line the full length of the border strip. The bottom of the wheels & the bottom most part of the track should form a straight line.

- Draw the Outer Edge line 6 ½" opposite of the Inner Edge line. The drawn line is the full length of the border strip. The **length** of the border strips have not been cut yet.
- Cut "only" the long INNER EDGE side on each border strip. See the red dotted line in the picture.


Write Do Not Cut on the Outer Edge line on the fabric to help you remember not to cut that side of the fabric strip.





Sewing on the Embroidered Borders




Use scant quarter inch seams.


Always finger press first to avoid stretching the fabric out of shape.

Press and starch the seams to the Inner Border.

Side Borders:

- Align the centers of the Side Embroidered Borders
 (use stitched in center line, see LEFT blue arrow) with the
 center of the coordinating Sashing Side on the Quilt Top
 (see RIGHT red arrow).
- 2. Pin frequently. This method works great because the Terial Magic and Shape Flex keep the fabric from stretching.
- 3. Sew and press seams toward Sashing.
- Instead of cutting the Side Borders to the exact length, DRAW (do not cut) a
 horizontal line where the cut line would be (matching the edge of the
 sashing to the drawn line on the border).
- 5. Trim both **long ends** of the Embroidered Borders **2" longer** than the **newly drawn line** (this gives you 2" extra fabric if needed to adjust the seams or squaring up in the next step. The exact length will be trimmed later).






Top & Bottom Borders

- Repeat Steps #1, #2 & #3 above. As you pin the edges of the Top & Bottom borders to the
 quilt top, align the raw edges of the Top & Bottom Borders to match the drawn line of the
 Side Border. This keeps the borders "square". (See Align top border here sign above)
- 2. Trim the long length of the Top & Bottom Borders to the same width as the quit top.


DO NOT trim the "**DO NOT CUT**" marked outer edge width on any of the borders.

NOTE:


When the all borders are sewn on and pressed flat, place a large square ruler on the corners. (see red box indicating the square ruler in the upper right corner of the quilt). The seam lines should be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the ruler.



If the lines are not parallel & perpendicular, pick them out and re-sew them.

Sometimes the corners like to pull in.

This is why pinning frequently helps!



When the seams line up perfectly square with the ruler, trim the extra 2" length off the **Side Borders seam allowance to 1/4".**

Remove the Stitched in Center Lines
Remove the center marks on the Sashing.

Please Read before embroidering!

Helpful Hints:

 Hooping: Please make sure you hoop the corners STRAIGHT. The seam lines on your fabric must be parallel and perpendicular with the grid lines on the template. It is MORE important to hoop the corners straight than to have the arrow post it note in the exact position. You can always move the design up/down/left/right when you get to the machine.

Do not use any **drawn lines** to hoop the fabric straight, use the **seam lines**.


2. **Orientation**: The fabric must be hooped straight so the incoming design sits **straight/square** in the corner.

For instance the trees, railroad signal and water tower must be straight/ square with the corner to look correct.

I do not want you to rotate the design at all (no pin point or precise positioning) I merely want you to move the design into the correct position by using the Move Up/Down/Left/Right icon.

Resizing: If the design needs to be resized to fit the area, use the Proportional Sizing icon.
 If possible, Unlock the icon so you will have the ability to alter the length, & width individually, not proportionately.

Each of the corner designs can be altered 1%-7% without a problem!! i.e. 100% adjusted to 103% wider and/or 100% adjusted to 98% shorter.



In both examples above, the **start & end arrows** touch the **top outer edge** of the rails. It is preferable to align like the instructions see **Example #1**, but it's just fine to adjust the incoming design to fit the area like in **Example #2**.

The first stitch of Color #1 (green start arrow) must touch anywhere on the top outer edge of the rail. (get as close as you can to the original alignment)

The last stitch of Color #1 (red end arrow) must touch anywhere on the top outer edge of the rail. (get as close as you can to the original alignment)




Fabric Position:

To hoop this design the Top of the Fabric is Rotated to the BOTTOM of the hoop.

The fabric is upside down!

Hoop the fabric with the arrow on the grid pointing to the green start arrow see Example #6.

The SEAM lines on the guilt top must be parallel and perpendicular to the lines on the grid so you hoop straight. **REMOVE** the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module.

Float heavy weight tear away stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop.

No Thread Color #1 Placement Line. The needle is positioned at the green start arrow see Example #6. The arrow on the grid points to the upper left corner of the black outline. Sew Color #1 without thread: it sews from the start arrow downward following the outline (shown in red) on the **Bottom Border** track to the outline on the Left Border track. It follows nothing between the two! Re-position if needed to follow the outlines on



REMOVE the grid from the hoop and attach the hoop to the module.

Float one piece of heavy weight tear away stabilizer (sprayed with 505) under the attached hoop.

No Thread Color #1 **Placement Line.** The needle is positioned at the green start arrow see **Example #7.** The arrow on the grid points to the **green start arrow.** Sew Color #1 without thread: it sews from the lower left tip of the center rail upward (Placement Line shown in red) following the **outer edge** of the track to the end arrow. Re-position if needed to follow the outline of the tracks.



Trim the Embroidered Borders



Always draw the "cutting lines" on the quilt top before actually trimming the borders to the size needed.

The Embroidered Borders will be trimmed to about 61/4 wide +/-.

The overall size after cutting the borders is 451/2" square.


Measure the drawn square to make sure it is 45½" before cutting.

Place a **Large Square & Straight Edge Ruler** across the quilt top to make sure the drawn lines are "square" with each other before cutting. In other words, the drawn Side Lines are perpendicular to the Top & Bottom lines.

You may need to make one border a little wider/narrower to get the 45 1/2" square.

Be very careful when cutting that the ruler doesn't shift or move!!!

Trim the quilt top to 45½ square.



Outer Border Prep



The Quilt top measures 45 ½ " square.	
Outer Border Fabric Cut the long length of the fabric in half. (2) 22" x Length of Fabric (set one aside for binding)	
	Extra Border Fabric

Interfacing: Shape Flex 101 by Pellon (see page #6 for instructions)

Iron **Shape Flex** to the wrong side of the **Outer Border Fabric**.

WHY????? The Outer Border Fabric will now have the same texture and weight like the rest of the Quilt top, making it easier to piece and quilt.

Cut the Outer Borders

Cut (4) 4" wide x Length of Border Fabric

The width can be however wide you would desire!

Sew the **Left & Right** Borders to the Quilt top.

Pin frequently to avoid stretching.

Finger press the seams to the border then use iron to press.

Trim the side borders to height of the quilt.

Sew the **Top & Bottom** borders accordingly to the Quilt top. Pin frequently to avoid stretching.

Finger press the seams to the border then use the iron to press. Trim the top & bottom borders to width of the quilt.

If you prefer narrower borders, trim the width of the Outer Border after sewing it to the quilt top.

Congratulations!!!! Time to quilt, bind...and enjoy!!
