

Plays Well with Others Supply List

Polka Dot Pincushion – July 18, 2026



Learn the wonderful process of string piecing on fabric foundation while making this fun quilt. The sample quilt measures 48" x 58" but the pattern includes three additional size options. This is a great way to use those fabulous scraps we all have in our stash and those annoying partial bobbins!

Fabric Requirements (based on 40" wide usable fabric)

Sample Size (48" x 58")

Foundation Fabric – a consistent fabric used to create the stars – 2 yards (light fabric in sample) – cut into 5 ½" squares
(see Pre-Class Work note below)

Prints – a variety of scraps that measure at least 1 ½" x at least 6 ¾" - approx. 3 ½ yards total ****SEE NOTE BELOW****

Border 1 (1" finished) – ⅓ yard (black and white stripe in sample – *not needed for workshop*)

Border 2 (3" finished) – 1 yard (light fabric in sample – same as foundation fabric, but it does not have to be – *not needed for workshop*)

Binding – ½ yard **OR** 225" of scrappy binding (*not needed for workshop*)

Backing – 3 yards (*not needed for workshop*)

Additional Size Options

Quilt Size	63" x 73"	73" x 83"	83" x 93"
Foundation Fabric	2 ⅞ yards	3 ⅞ yards	5 ⅞ yards
Prints (Scraps)	approx. 5 yds	approx. 7 yds	approx. 9 ⅓ yds
Border 1 (1 ½" finished)	½ yard	½ yard	½ yard
Border 2 (5" finished)	1 yard	1 ⅞ yards	1 ¾ yards
Binding	⅓ yard	⅓ yard	¾ yard

Pre-Class Work

Coming to the workshop with at least some of your 5 ½" foundation squares cut (80 are needed for the sample size quilt) and at least some 1 ½" x 6 ¾" scraps (Do NOT cut all of them) will mean you can jump right into the construction of the blocks. **You can cut scraps into strips that measure 1 ½" x whatever length, at least 6 ¾" and bring those. This will allow you to have a little more freedom when choosing which strips to use during the block construction.******

Other Supplies Needed

Plays Well with Others pattern

Sewing machine with ¼" seam foot (including power cord and foot pedal)

Thread for piecing – any neutral color (grey, beige, etc.) This is a great opportunity to use those partial bobbins. 😊

Basic Sewing Supplies - Pins, Scissors, Seam Ripper, etc.

Mechanical Pencil – thin line (.5 size lead)

Rotary Cutting Supplies – cutter with a sharp blade, small mat (doesn't need to be longer than 12") and rulers (small square ruler at least 5 ½" or 6" square for trimming and a longer one - at least 12" long for cutting yardage)
