

The entire background took almost 1 spool of Kreinik, but you could use any sparkly thread

We add a bit more of everything in order to feed more people and in no time, you have a fabulous dinner. 







Two different designs for an initial...







Recipe Corner Sheet Pan Chicken Fajitas

(from eat yourself skinny.com)

- 1 1/2 lb. boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into 1/2-inch strips
- 3 bell peppers, thinly sliced (I used red, yellow, green)
- 1 onion, thinly sliced
- 2 Tbsp olive oil
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- 2 tsp chili powder
- 1 tsp cumin
- 1 tsp paprika
- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- 1/2 tsp oregano
- Juice of 1 lime
- 3 Tbsp chopped cilantro
- Optional toppings: sour cream, avocado, shredded cheese, salsa
- Serve with flour tortillas or lettuce cups

INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.

Spread chicken, peppers and onions on a baking sheet sprayed with some cooking spray, drizzle with olive oil and season with salt and pepper.

In a small bowl, combine chili powder, cumin, paprika, garlic powder and oregano. Sprinkle the spices evenly over the chicken and peppers, tossing to coat and spread out in a single layer on the baking sheet.

Bake in the oven for about 20 to 25 minutes, tossing halfway through, and continue cooking until veggies are tender and chicken is cooked through. (if you want some char on your veggies, remove chicken from baking sheet and pop veggies under the broiler for about 3 to 5 minutes until the edges start to char slightly.)

Drizzle with lime juice and sprinkle with fresh cilantro. Serve with lettuce cups or tortillas and desired toppings. Enjoy!

RASPBERRY LIMONCELLO SANGRIA

1 Cup fresh or frozen raspberries, rinsed

Zest of 1 lemon

3 ounces pink lemonade

2 ounces Limoncello or other lemon liqueur

750 ml bottle Prosecco or other sparkling wine

About 3 cups ice cube (optional)

In a large glass pitcher (at least 2 quart), mix together the raspberries, lemon zest and Limoncello. Refrigerate for about 2 hours.

When ready to serve, slowly add the sparkling wine, stirring gently with a long handled wooden spoon. Fill wine glasses with ice cube, if using, and slowly pour the sangria over the ice, allowing raspberries to fall in the wine glass. Enjoy!
