Welcome to July! Summer is officially here and so is the heat; however, it is Christmas in July here at Louise's! We are offering 20% off all Christmas canvases and 50% off stocking toppers and full-size stockings. If the heat is really getting to you, what better way to take your mind off the heat and into cooler weather than stitching on a new Christmas project.

July also brings with it several finishing deadlines. The first is July 19 for Halloween. Then August 1st for Thanksgiving and Hanukah and August 8th for Christmas. The finishing date for stockings is September 21. Getting your finishing here sooner is better than waiting. We will be sending items to the finisher weekly during the month of July. To help you get motivated to get your finishing in this month, we are putting names in a jar for every finishing item that comes in during the month of July. If you bring in 6 items, you get 6 entries. At the end of the month we will be drawing for a \$50.00 gift certificate! So, get your items in and you could be the winner!

When you get ready to bring your finishing in, it helps us and the finisher if you have an idea of the colors and types of fabric you want for backing and cording. Also, you need to decide if you want a bow or feet on your items. If you have a stand up, what depth do you want for your piece. Remember this is your piece and not ours. We are happy to have the finishers customize your piece to your liking. If you cannot make up your mind, most finisher will put their choice of finishings on your piece.

In August we are hosting our first ever Stitching Retreat. Our retreat will be held August 24th and 25th at the Inn at Honey Run in Millersburg, Ohio. I will be going up Friday night to set up. Most rooms are equipped with a King size bed, but several have day beds which make room sharing a possibility. This being our first retreat, we are not offering a specific project, each stitcher will receive a retreat bag filled with surprises for the weekend. There will be a small retreat fee. Room costs and meals will be each participants' responsibility. Louise's will be providing extra refreshments and snacks. Call the shop for information. Space is limited to 10 people and as of this newsletter we have 6 people so only 4 spots are left.






Lines in Needlepoint: Part Two - Wrapping, Weaving and Width by Diane Snyder

Last month I showed you three different ways to stitch straight and curved lines and how each method gave a different width relative to each other. Those lines were backstitch, stem stitch, and chain stitch. This month I'd like to show you how adding elements to those basic stitches will also add relative width and more dimension to the line.

The first element is a wrapping stitch. This diagram shows the wrapping stitch over chain stitch, but the concept is the same for all three stitches.

Working a wrapping stitch adds some dimension to the backstitch line without adding too much width. Working a wrapping stitch over a stem stitch line accomplishes the same effect; in addition, the wrapping stitch can be further used to refine placement in the curved areas of the stitch. Working a wrapping stitch over chain stitch can achieve two different looks. The wraps will pull the loops of the chain together if you use more tension, thinning the width slightly. Using a looser tension will add width as long as you do not pull the loops together



The second element is a woven stitch. Once again, the diagram shows the stitch being worked over the chain stitch line. This weaving adds width to all three lines. Since the weaving remains underneath the line stitches, they do not draw the line stitches tighter or together. For the best look, try to maintain your tension so that the woven loops are all the same size. For even more width; you can also work another line of weaving in the opposite direction so that you have loops on both sides of the line.

WRAPPED CHAIN Bring your needle up underneat

the first stitch. Take the thread over the top of the stitch and

under the next stitch. Keep the thread on the front of the canvas


until you reach the end of the

In the stitched sample, you can see how adding these elements affects the lines. All lines and elements were stitched using 1 strand of Caron Impressions.

Top to bottom: Back Stitch, Wrapped Back Stitch, Woven Back Stitch, Stem Stitch, Wrapped Stem Stitch, Woven Stem Stitch, Chain Stitch, Wrapped Chain Stitch, Woven Chain Stitch.

Your stitching tension and thread choices can all affect the width of the line as well, but this is a basic way of using different stitches and elements to control the widths of lines in needlepoint.
