
With Spring upon us we will be doing some spring cleaning and rearranging in the shop. Also, we may have a day where we close and take care of some changes that we need to make. What better way to show off new things than with a new and rearranged store?

Some things, however, have not changed. Canvas orders are taking up to 6 months, thread deliveries are slow, and finishing is taking 6 to 9 months. We are doing our best to choose finishers that will do the best for you and your piece depending on the design and your requests. Many finishers are not even guaranteeing 2021 Christmas delivery. We know how hard this is as even we are waiting on our personal pieces. So, keep stitching and know that we ship out finishing every week; however, we have had our finishing numbers more than double in the last year. Try to be patient as we will continue to advocate for you and get you the best product we can.

Our Trunk Show this month is from Shelly Tribbey designs. There are so many great pieces in this show and to my knowledge there has never been a Tribbey show in Ohio. The mini skates are Shelly's signature pieces, and they are so adorable! Another favorite are her Halloween pieces that come with the coffin. Many of the larger pieces in this show come not only on 18 mesh but 13 mesh as well, which is so nice to have. This show will be with us throughout the month so stop in or follow our Instagram and Facebook to see this huge selection of canvases. Recipe Corner

Slow Cooker Reuben Dip

1 jar or bag sauerkraut (about 32 ounces)

-drain and rinse with cold water

2 cups shredded swiss cheese

½ cup butter (1 stick), melted

1 – 1 ½ cups corned beef – shredded

1 egg, beaten

Rye cocktail bread or crackers

Slow Cooker Directions:

- Combine all ingredients except rye bread in a slow cooker.
- Cover and cook on High for 2 hours, stir occasionally.

Serve with rye cocktail bread or crackers

Irish Brownies

4 squares (1 ounce each) semisweet baking chocolate, coarsely chopped

½ cup butter

½ cup sugar

2 eggs

¼ cup Irish cream liqueur

1 cup flour

½ tsp baking powder

¼ tsp salt

Irish Cream frosting – see below

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease an 8 inch square baking pan.

Melt chocolate and butter in medium saucepan over low heat, stir constantly. Remove from heat. Stir in sugar. Beat in eggs, one at a time with wire whisk. Whisk in liqueur. Combine flour, baking powder and salt in small bowl. Stir flour mixture into chocolate mixture until just blended. Spread batter evenly in prepared pan.

Bake for 22-25 minutes or until center is set – do not overbake. Remove pan to wire rack and cool completely.

Irish Cream Frosting:

Beat with and electric mixer until smooth:

¼ cup (2 ounces) cream cheese, softened

2 Tbls. soft butter

Beat in 2 Tbls. Irish cream liqueur

Gradually beat in 1 ½ cups powdered sugar until smooth.


Spread frosting over cooled brownies.

Chill brownies at least 1 hour or until frosting is set. Cut into 2 inch squares
