Supply List

☐ Required Pattern: **Blue Moon Placemats** by Quiltworx.com

• Fabric requirements (makes 6 placemats):

- ☐ B2-1: 1/2 yd (18") for Skinny Spike Background, **Cut into (3) 6" strips**
- ☐ B2-2: 1/4 yd (or 5") **each of (5) fabrics** for Skinny Spikes, **Cut each into (2) 2-1/2" strips**
- ☐ D1-1: 1-1/2 yd (54") for Wide Spike Background, **Cut into (3) 18" strips**
- ☐ D1-2: 1/2 yd (or 16") for Wide Spikes (used 4 times in each unit), **Cut into (2) 8" strips**
- ☐ D1-3: 1/2 yd (or 16") for Wide Spikes (used 3 times in each unit), **Cut into (2) 8" strips**
- ☐ Binding: 7/8 yd (needed to finish, but not in class)
- ☐ Backing: 2-1/4 yd (needed to finish, but not in class)



(finished size 12" x 18")

☐ Sewing machine in good working order, fitted with your 1/4-inch piecing foot (if you can't see the needle well with your 1/4" foot, also bring an open-toe foot or clear foot with a mark for the needle).

• Notions:

- ☐ Two rulers: one long ruler (18-24" recommended) and one smaller (12" or so)
- ☐ Quiltworx Leaf Ruler or similar (optional for trimming curves)*
- ☐ 12" Add-a-Quarter Ruler
- ☐ 2-3" x 12" piece of Template Plastic
- ☐ Rotary Cutter with a fresh blade
- ☐ Cutting Mat
- ☐ Pressing Mat and Small Iron
- ☐ 50 wt Thread and Bobbin
- ☐ Size 70-80 needle (Microtex Sharp recommended)
- ☐ Small Scissors for trimming threads
- ☐ Paper Cutting Scissors
- ☐ Flowerhead Pins or other long, thin pins
- ☐ Pen, Paper and highlighter for taking notes
- ☐ Seam Ripper
- ☐ Scotch Tape
- ☐ Jumbo Paper Clips (about 30)
- ☐ 3 Ziplock Bags, gallon size
- ☐ Fabric Glue Pen (Sewline, Fons & Porter, or similar)
- ☐ Scotch Repositionable (Restickable) Glue Stick – Note that some other brands are only repositionable for a certain amount of time, such as 5 minutes, before drying. You DO NOT want that type of glue stick.
- ☐ Purple Thang or Stiletto
- ☐ Sharpie Marker, any color except black
- ☐ Acorn Easy Press Pen w/Acorn Easy Press Fabric Treatment Refill (optional for achieving crisp, flat seams)
- ☐ Tweezers (optional for aiding with paper removal)
- ☐ 3-Ring binder (1/2" or 1") and Sheet Protectors (**optional** for storing pattern)

*A curved ruler can be used to trim the curved units and fabric pieces. The curve won't fit exactly, but it does make cutting curves more comfortable for some students. You can also trim curves using scissors or freehand with your rotary cutter.
