

Twinkle Star

Quiltworx Paper Piecing Workshop

Supply List

- Required Pattern: **Twinkle Star** by Quiltworx.com
- Fabric requirements:
 - (9) 2-1/2" strips for center star diamonds
 - 7/8 yd (or 31"), cut into (4) 7-3/4" strips for spike background
 - (8) 2-1/2" strips for spikes
 - 1/8 yd (or 3-1/4") for spike base
 - 1/2 yd (or 13-1/2") for inner (wide) border
 - 1/4 yd (or 8") for middle (narrow) border
 - 1/2 yd (or 17-1/2") for outer border
 - Binding: 1/2 yd (needed to finish, but not in class)
 - Backing: 2-5/8 yd (needed to finish, but not in class)



(finished size 38" x 38")

Fabric Notes: You can choose to make all the spikes the same, or use 2, 4, or 8 different fabrics. The class sample uses 4 fabrics, so that each fabric is used in 2 spike blocks. The finished quilt size is 38", which is 4-6" smaller than the typical width of fabric. If you plan to quilt on a domestic machine and don't need a lot of overhang, then use 1-1/4 yd for the backing instead of the 2-5/8 yd called for in the pattern.

- Sewing machine in good working order, fitted with your 1/4-inch piecing foot
- Notions:
 - Two rulers: one long ruler (24" recommended) and one smaller (12" or so)
 - 12" Add-a-Quarter Ruler
 - 2"-3" x 12" piece of Template Plastic
 - Rotary Cutter with a fresh blade
 - Cutting Mat
 - Pressing Mat and Small Iron
 - 50 wt Thread and Bobbin
 - Size 70-80 needle (Microtex Sharp recommended)
 - Small Scissors for trimming threads
 - Paper Cutting Scissors
 - Flowerhead Pins or other long, thin pins
 - Pen, Paper and highlighter for taking notes
 - Seam Ripper
 - Scotch Tape
 - 7 Ziplock Bags, gallon size
 - Fabric Glue Pen (Sewline, Fons & Porter, or similar)
 - Scotch Repositionable (Restickable) Glue Stick – Note that some other brands are only repositionable for a certain amount of time, such as 5 minutes, before drying. You DO NOT want that type of glue stick.
 - Purple Thang or Stiletto
 - Sharpie Marker, any color except black
 - Acorn Easy Press Pen w/Acorn Easy Press Fabric Treatment Refill (optional for achieving crisp, flat seams)
 - Tweezers (optional for aiding with paper removal)
 - 3-Ring Binder (1/2" or 1") and 9 Sheet Protectors (optional for storing pattern)
