

Christmas Tree Turned-Appiqué by Machine

Love the look of Hand Appiqué but just don't have the time for handwork? Try this technique that will make your machine appiqué look as if it was done by hand and only take a fraction of the time too! Learn all about the tricks and tools you need for success. Your quilt will look like you sat for hours and needle-turned by hand each piece!

Supplies for the Christmas Tree Applique:

****Sewing machine with zig-zag stitch****

Scissors (paper and fabric) and pencil

Mono-filament thread

Extra bobbin

Water-soluble glue stick

Basic sewing supplies; basic rotary cutting supplies, 12 inch square ruler

Light table is nice to have but not necessary.

amounts are generous.

	fabric
Tree	1 fat quarter or a selection of green scraps
Stump	Small scrap of brown
Background	8-1/2" square
Border and binding	1/4 yard or a Fat Quarters
Backing Fabric	Fat Quarter or 16" inch square
Batting	16" square
Embellishments	Buttons and beads to decorate the tree!
