

Class Name: Tumbling Triangles

Required:

Pattern: ***Tumbling Triangles*** by Running With Scissors Quilters

Tool: V Block.

Equipment and Supplies: Basic sewing including a sewing machine with accurate 1/4" seam. Other: cutting mat, rotary cutter, 100% cotton thread.

Class Description: By combining two contrasting fabrics, you will create triangles tumbling down the quilt using the V Block tool. This is a fun quick project! Great quilt for a college student or sports fan.

Fabric Requirements: as listed on the pattern. This pattern utilizes the 1inch increments in making the block units from 1 " to 6". Determine the size quilt you want to make, this will determine the size block units you will be making.

Refer to pattern for yardage requirements

Example:

40" x 40"	Dark fabric	1 3/8 yd
	Light Fabric	1 3/4 yd

Pre Cut Instructions:

Based on size quilt top you are making -- follow the **cutting instructions on page 1 of the pattern directions** to cut your strips and squares. Do not worry about any subcutting of the strips as we will review that in class.

Example: for 40" x 40" (makes 3" V Block units)

Dark: Cut (5) 4" width of fabric strips
Cut (2) 10" squares
Cut (1) 5 1/4" square
Cut (2) strips 3 1/2" x 46"

Light: Cut (6) 4" width of fabric strips
Cut (2) 10" squares
Cut (1) 5 1/4" square

Cut (2) strips 3 1/2" x 46"
