Board Of Education Of South Summit School District Bond Election

Shall the Board of Education of South Summit School District, Utah, be authorized to issue General Obligation Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed Eighty Seven Million Dollars (\$87,000,000) for the purpose of paying all or a portion of the costs to acquire land, acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping new school facilities, improving or rebuilding existing facilities, and the authorization and issuance of the Bonds due and payable with a term not to exceed twenty-one (21) years from the date or dates of issuance of the Bonds? PROPERTY TAX COST OF THE BONDS if the Bonds are issued as planned, an annual property tax to pay debt service on the Bonds will be required over a period of twenty-one (21) years in the estimated amount of \$358 on a \$423,000 residence and in the estimated amount of \$651 on a business property having the same value. The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the District may be required to levy to pay debt service on the Bonds. The District is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds.
