- D. Report and Approval of Bills to be paid

There was a discussion regarding the payment to Gateway Grill. The Council was under the impression that they were a sponsor, so why was the City paying them \$4,813.20. Bonnie Jones stated that the Gateway Grill was a sponsor. They were giving us a break on the cost of the sponsors' dinner. The Rodeo Committee has contacted several other caterers and the sponsors' dinners would cost around \$25.00 per person. Sam Aplanalp indicated that the contract with Gateway Catering was ambiguous. The Rodeo Committee said that they would make sure that next year's contract with Gateway Catering would be more detailed.

- A. Jeremy Anderson – charity races

Jeremy told the Council that he is a runner and has had to start running at night. He enjoys the fireflies as he runs along Woodenshoe. He would like to start a fund raising race called the Firefly Run. The race would start about 10pm; he isn't sure exactly which weekend he would hold the event. It would be sometime the last of June or 1st week in July, depending when the fireflies are out. He would like to use the ball field at the Rodeo Complex for parking and staging the event.

B. Roads and Signs

He stated that on a trip to Southern Utah he saw a sign that would monitor your speed, if you were speeding red and blue lights would flash. When you slowed down the lights would flash yellow.
