**3. New Business**

- A. RV parking at the Arena/Rentals of City Buildings and Property

Councilor Rydalch and Hoggan stated that they didn't remember talking about it since the fee schedule was approved. Councilor Bowen stated that it isn't hurting anyone to have them at the arena and it helps pay the utilities. Councilor Woolstenhulme specified that the Council didn't need to make a decision tonight, they just needed to think about it.

B. Purchasing of New Lawn Motor

Councilor Bowen reported the oldest lawn mower had broken down and would cost over \$2,000.00 to repair. The Kubota Dealership will take the old mower as a trade in on the purchase of a newer model. He felt it was better to have a new mower. The new mower with the trade in would be around \$7,900.00. He had called on two other brands and the Kubota Dealer was right in line with their prices.

The City really needs to have a purchasing policy. If we don't have a purchasing policy it reverts to the State Code. The Council asked that Tami and Konni gather some policies from other cities to get some ideas to write are own policy.
