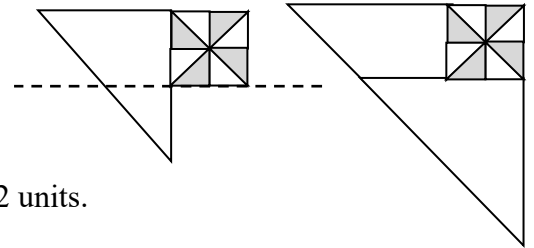
**SIDE UNITS:**

Background: Cut (3) 9 ½” x WOF strips, then cut into (12) 9 ½” squares. Cut squares apart diagonally, TWICE (side setting triangles)

Cut (2) 6 ¾” squares, then cut diagonally ONCE (corners)

You will need 22 side setting triangles with a pinwheel block sewn in.

Stitch a pinwheel block to a background triangle as shown.



Trim even with bottom of pinwheel block.

Stitch a second background triangle to bottom of unit. Press. Make 22 units.

The remainder of the quilt is put together in sections. Lay out the completed blocks for each section as shown in diagram on next page. Stitch blocks together in diagonal rows. Press.

Stitch Section 1 to center section, matching seams. Press. Continue adding sections in numerical order, clockwise. Press.
