# Nancy’ Fancy 

## BARGELLO BORDERS (Revised 06/26/21)

*WOF = width of fabric from selvage to selvage

## It is helpful to keep strips together by Unit number.

## Fabric A:

Cut (1) $10-1 / 2 " x$ WOF strip, then cut into:
(12) $1-1 / 4 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces (Center of side border sets)
(10) $1-3 / 8 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces (Center of top and bottom border sets)
(1) $8-1 / 2 " \times 10 "$ piece (Unit 1)

Cut (3) $8-1 / 2$ " x WOF strips (Unit 1)
Cut (3) $6-1 / 2 " x$ WOF strips, then:
Set aside (2) strips for Unit 2
Cut (1) strip into: (1) 6-1/2" x 24 " piece (Unit 2) and (1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 12 "$ piece (Unit 4)
Cut (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips (Unit 3)
Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip (Unit 4)
Cut (4) 5" squares, then cut once diagonally (Triangles in corner sets)

## Fabric B:

Cut (1) $10-1 / 2 " x$ WOF strip, then cut into:
(8) $1-7 / 8 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces (Joins top and bottom border sets)
(8) $1-1 / 4 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces (Corner Blocks)
(10) $1-1 / 2 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces (Joins side border sets)

Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips (Unit 3)
Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip (Unit 4)
Cut (1) 2-1/2" x 12" strip (Unit 4)

## Fabric C:

Cut (5) $2-1 / 2 " x$ WOF strips and separate into: (2) Unit 2, (2) Unit 3, (1) Unit 4
Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, then cut into:
(1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 24$ " piece (Unit 2)
(1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 12 "$ piece (Unit 4)

## Fabric F:

Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips (Unit 1)
Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips (Unit 2)
Cut (1) 2-1/2" x 24 " strip (Unit 2)
Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips (Unit 3)
Cut (1) $2-1 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip (Unit 4)
Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, then cut into:
(1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 10 "$ piece (Unit 1)
(1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 12 "$ piece (Unit 4)

## Fabric G:

Cut (1) $2-1 / 2 " x$ WOF strip (Unit 4)
Cut (1) $2-1 / 2 "$ x 12 " piece (Unit 4)

## BORDER STRIP SETS:

## UNIT 1:

1. Sew the long side of an $8-1 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric A to the long side of a $2-1 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric F. Press toward Fabric A. Make 3 sets.
2. Sew the $8-1 / 2 " \times 10 "$ Fabric A to the $2-1 / 2 " \times 10 "$ Fabric F. Press toward Fabric A.
3. Cut the four strata into (52) $2-1 / 2 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces. Label and keep together. This is Unit 1.

## UNIT 2:

1. Sew (1) $6-1 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric A piece to (1) $2-1 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric F. Press toward Fabric F. Sew (1) $2-1 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric C strip to Fabric F. Make 2 sets.
2. Sew (1) $6-1 / 2 " \times 24 "$ Fabric A piece to (1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 24 "$ Fabric F. Press toward Fabric F. Sew (1) $2-1 / 2 " \times 24 "$ Fabric C strip to Fabric F.
3. Cut the strata into (52) 2 " $\times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces. Label and keep together. This is Unit 2.

## UNIT 3:

1. Sew (1) $4-1 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric A strip to (1) $2-1 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric F strip. Sew (1) $2-1 / 2$ " $x$ WOF Fabric C piece to Fabric F. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x WOF Fabric B to Fabric C. Repeat.
2. Cut strata into (52) $1-1 / 2 " \times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces. Label and keep together. This is Unit 3 .

## UNIT 4:

1. Gather the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips of Fabrics A, F, C, B, and G together and sew together in this same order.
2. Gather the $2-1 / 2 " \times 12 "$ pieces of Fabrics A, F, C, B, and G together and sew together in this same order.
3. Cut the strata into (52) 1 " $\times 10-1 / 2 "$ pieces. Label and keep together. This is Unit 4.

BORDERS: For left and right border units, sew pieces in this order. Make 12 sets. Sew 6 sets together with (1) 1-1/2" Fabric B strip between each set. Make 2 sets of 6 . Sew to each side of quilt.

For top and bottom border units, sew pieces in the same order as for the left and right borders.
Make 10 sets. Sew 5 units together with a $1-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece between each set to make the top border. Make 2 sets of 5 .

## CORNERS:




On wrong side of Left Units, measure 10-1/2" from the comer toward the triangle and make a mark. Connect that mark to the lower outer edge of the Fabric B strip and draw a diagonal line across the block. This will be the sewing


1. Right sides together, sew on drawn line. Trim excess fabric from seam, open and press seams open.
2. Trim to $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
3. Make 4.
4. Sew Comer Blocks to the ends of the top and bottom borders with Fabric B strips toward the borders and the pieced triangles toward outer comers of the quilt.
5. Sew top and bottom borders to the quilt.
6. Leave the comers square or round them off by tracing around a plate or saucer and cut on the line.
7. Layer quilt with batting and quilt.

## BINDING

1. Cut (9) $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sew end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and press. Stitch to top using $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Fold to back side of quilt and hand or machine stitch to finish.
