

BLOCK B—9-1/2” Unfinished, 9” Finished

Per Block Requirement:


- (3) 3-1/2” Background squares
- (1) 3-1/2” x 9-1/2” Background rectangle
- (3) “H” units

Pay attention to the direction the “H” Unit faces.

Instructions:

1. Sew (1) 3-1/2” Background square between (2) “H” Units as shown (Fig. 3).
2. Sew (1) “H” Unit between (2) 3-1/2” Background squares.
3. Sew step 1 unit to bottom of (1) 3-1/2” x 9-1/2” Background rectangle.
4. Sew step 2 unit to the bottom of step 3 unit.
5. Refer to table on page 2 for number of blocks to make for each quilt size.

BLOCK C—9-1/2” Unfinished, 9” Finished

Per Block Requirement:


- (5) 3-1/2” Background squares
- (4) “H” units

Pay attention to the direction the “H” Unit faces.

Instructions:

1. Sew (1) “H” Unit between (2) 3-1/2” Background squares (Fig. 4). Repeat.
2. Sew (1) 3-1/2” Background square between (2) “H” Units as shown.
3. Assemble block as shown.
4. Refer to table on page 2 for number of blocks to make for each quilt size.

BLOCK D—9-1/2” Unfinished, 9” Finished

Per Block Requirement:


- (1) 3-1/2” Background square
- (6) 1-1/2” x 3-1/2” Background rectangles
- (6) “H” units

Pay attention to the direction the “H” Unit faces.

Instructions:

1. Sew (3) 1-1/2” x 3-1/2” Background rectangles to (2) “H” Units as shown (Fig. 5). Repeat.
2. Sew (1) 3-1/2” Background square between (2) “H” Units.
3. Assemble block as shown.
4. Refer to table on page 2 for number of blocks to make for each quilt size.

BLOCK E—9-1/2” Unfinished, 9” Finished

Per Block Requirement:


- (4) 5” Background squares

Instructions:

1. Sew squares together in pairs, then join the pairs as shown (Fig. 6).
2. Refer to table on page 2 for number of blocks to make for each quilt size.

Note: If using one background fabric, Block E is one 9-1/2” square. Gather as many as needed for quilt size.

Assemble Quilt

Refer to diagram on the next page for the layout for the Twin size quilt. Modify for other sizes by adding or subtracting the blocks in each column and row to match the quilts in the following pages.

Be careful with the rotation of “A”, “B” and “D” blocks. Before sewing, take pictures to verify that you see the “rings” in the correct positions.

Sew together in rows first, then join the rows.

Borders

1. Join the border strips together using diagonal seams.
2. Measure the middle of the quilt body, top to bottom, and cut (2) strips to this length. Sew to each side of the quilt body. Press toward border.
3. Measure the middle of the quilt, side to side, and cut (2) strips to this length. Sew to top and bottom of quilt body. Press toward border.
