CLASS DESCRIPTION

It's time to finish the stunning Starry Night Santa tiling scene that you have been working on. The first day we will begin assembly and learn how to match the tiles so that they line up exactly. If you do not complete this in class, you will have time to finish this process at home before our second meeting when we will form our quilt sandwich, quilt, and add the binding.

SUPPLIES

- Finishing instructions (pages 36 - 38) printed out from Starry Night Santa Instructions PDF file on the CD.
- Completed embroidered tiles, trimmed 1/2" beyond the seam line from the back. You stitched this seam with a bright color so it would be easy to see. Be sure to trim away stabilizer, press and square up your tiles before cutting if needed. Follow the instructions on your PDF (page 36) for cutting these out.
- Thread to match the background.
- Quarter Inch foot or standard presser foot.
- Basic Sewing Supplies, including rotary cutter, wonder clips, scissors, pressing cloth, water spray bottle, etc.
- Sewing machine in good working order, power cord & foot, slide-on table. You will not need your embroidery module.
- Temporary Spray Adhesive (Day 2).
- 36" square piece of batting for quilt sandwich (Day2).
- 36" square piece of backing for quilt sandwich (Day2).
- Fabric for hanging sleeve. This should be approximately 8" x 36"
- 135" binding made with the same fabric as tiles background. The size depends on your preference. I usually use 2", but you may prefer 2 1/8" or 2 1/4" inch, folded in half (Day2).
- Quilt label if you want to attach it in class or you may choose to add it later (Day2).

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **10 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, Sew Many Quilts will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If Sew Many Quilts cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.
