Ruler Bag

³⁄₄ Yard Background Fabric (If you are choosing directional fabric, you may have to rotate the fabric. If that is the case, you will need 1 1/3 Yards).

1 1/2 Yards of 20" Flex-Foam, one side fusible

Lining (Inside)

³⁄₄ Yard Lining Fabric (If you are choosing directional fabric, you may have to rotate the fabric. If that is the case, you will need 1 1/3 Yards).

¾ Yard DecorBond

<u>Handles</u>

4 1/3 Yards of One-Inch Webbing. *

If you want to make the handles out of fabric, you will need ½ Yard. You will also need ½ yard DecorBond.

Pockets

(3) Fat Quarters2/3 Yard DecorBond

Lining for Pockets and Binding

One Yard

Other Supplies

Thread to match fabrics Walking Foot Microtex 14 Needles Rotary cutter, scissors, rulers, clips, FriXon pen or iron away chalk in wheel.

*If you are wanting a specific color for your bag and cannot find it locally, try Strapworks.com. Go to polypropylene webbing, 1-inch wide, lightweight. They are pretty fast in their delivery, but allow a week to receive it at least.

HOMEWORK TO COMPLETE BEFORE CLASS

• Cut fabric before class (see Fabric Cutting Instructions). This will save time for you and allow more time for sewing and designing. Be sure to label the pieces.

Ruler Bag Fabric Cutting Instructions

• You have two choices of the body of the ruler bag:

- Fourteen 2-1/2" x 22" strips sewn together lengthwise for both front and back of bag (28 total strips) OR
- Two fabric panels, cut 22" x 28"
- Cut Deco-Bond into two panels, 22" x 28"
- Cut batting into two panels, 22" x 28"
- Cut lining fabric into two panels, 22" x 28"
- You have two choices for handles; fabric or webbing.
 - If you are making handles out of fabric, cut four strips of handle fabric 4" wide by WOF. Also cut four strips of Deco-Bond Pellon 809 4" wide by WOF. OR
 - If you are making handles out of webbing, you need 4 yards of webbing.
