# SUNDAY RIDE ZIPPER POUCHES

Please read through all directions before beginning

- Cutting instructions are based on fabric that is at least 42" wide
- WOF = Width Of Fabric folded selvage to selvage
- All seam allowances are 1/4"
- Press all fabrics before cutting
- Stabilize backgrounds before embroidery

- Groz-Beckert Embroidery Needles #GB750802C
- OESD Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer
- 505 Spray Adhesive, Item #ORMD-13A
- Lite Steam A Seam 2 fusible
- Batting of your choice; samples are made with Bosal foam stabilizer.
- Fabric yardage is included with each project.

- Isacord Thread (see embroidery charts on CD)

Zipper:

1. Sew the Lt Teal background A to the Dk Teal background B on the long edge; press seam open.
2. Embroider design #80085-17 onto the pieced background; choose a favorite font to add a fun wording.



3. If desired, quilt the embroidered fabric and backing fabric using batting or Bosal.
4. Follow the Zipper Pouch Assembly instructions on page 4 to construct the zippered pouch.

LT TEAL	(1) 9 1/2" x 6" - Background A
DK TEAL	(1) 9 1/2" x 2 1/4" - Background B
BIKES	(1) 9 1/2" x 7 3/4" - Backing (2) 9 1/2" x 7 3/4" - Lining
BOSAL	(2) 9 1/2" x 7 3/4" - Batting

# SUNDAY RIDE ZIPPER POUCHES

FABRIC	CUT
LT TEAL	(1) 6½" x 9¾" - Background
DK TEAL	(1) 1½" x 9¾" - Inner strip
SAIL BOATS	(1) 2" x 9¾" - Outer strip (1) 11½" x 9¾" - Backing (2) 11½" x 9¾" - Lining
BOSAL	(2) 11½" x 9¾" - Batting

1. Embroider design #80085-25 onto the Lt Teal background.
2. Sew the Dk Teal strips onto the left and right edges of the embroidered background; sew the Sail Boats strips onto the left and right edges.



3. Quilt the embroidered piece and backing fabric using batting or Bosal.
4. Follow the Zipper Pouch Assembly instructions on page 4 to construct the pouch.

FABRIC	CUT
LT TEAL	(1) 14½" x 7¾" - Background A (4) 2½" x 2½" Pieced background
GREEN	(1) 14½" x 3½" - Background B
DK TEAL	(3) 2½" x 2½" Pieced background
HOUSES	(1) 14½" x 12¾" - Backing (2) 14½" x 12¾" - Lining
BOSAL	(2) 14½" x 12¾" - Batting

1. Sew the Lt Teal background A to the green background B on the long edge; press seam open.
2. Embroider designs #80085-01, 80025-21, 80085-03, 50085-05, 80085-24 onto the pieced background.



3. Embroider designs 80085-13, 80085-14, and 80085-15 onto the Lt and Dk Teal 2½" squares as follows:

4. Sew the embroidered 2½ Lt and Dk Teal squares in a row:

5. Sew the row onto the bottom edge of the embroidered pouch top.
6. If desired, quilt the top and backing fabric using batting or Bosal.
7. Follow the Zipper Pouch Assembly instructions to construct the pouch.



7. Pin the other side of the zipper face down onto the backing fabric; Lay the other lining piece over the zipper and stitch down.



8. Open both sides and press down.
9. Stitch 1/8" from the fold.



## ZIPPER POUCH ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut (2) 2" x 3" strips from a coordinating print and press a 1/4" in on the 2" edge.
2. Trim the metal ends of the zipper. Fold a tab in half over the trimmed zipper end and stitch down, securing the stitches.



3. Cut the folded edge, open the tab and trim the zipper to a 1/4".



4. Place the tab side over the embroidered pouch top, aligning the tab 1" from the right edge of the pouch top.
5. Repeat on the left side of the zipper/top, aligning the edges, then sew the tab onto the zipper and trim the excess.



6. Layer a lining piece right side down over the zipper and pin in place; stitch the zipper down along the edge.



10. Making sure the zipper is open, pin the lining fabric to each other with right sides together; pin the pouch top and backing, right sides together, and sew all edges down with a 1/4" seam allowance, leaving a 3" opening on the lining side to turn right side out.



11. Turn the pouch right side out; stitch the opening close and push the lining into the bag.



12. Optional... add a pull tab to the zipper and enjoy!
