$1 / 2$ yard Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B) 1063-90
$3 / 4$ yard Tossed Animals - Multi (C) 9563-91
$1 / 4$ yard Giraffe Skin - Tan (D) 9562-33
$1 / 4$ yard Tossed Glasses - Gray (E) 9565-91
$3 / 4$ yard Mini Dots - Orange (F) 9568-34*
$1 / 4$ yard Small Set Dots - Orange (G) 9567-43
3 yards Stripe - Multi (Backing) 9561-90
*Includes binding

## Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Large Blocks - Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 9 " $\times 10^{3 / 4}$ " rectangles, centered on the rabbit, the fox, the deer and the elephant.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B), cut:
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $103 / 4 "$ strips.

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x 12 " strips.

From the Tossed Animals - Multi (C), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 33 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 37 "$ WOF strips.
-(1) $51 / 2 "$ square.
From the Giraffe Skin - Tan (D), cut:
- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 "$ squares and
(4) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Tossed Glasses - Gray (E), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Mini Dots - Orange (F), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times 311 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times 29 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Small Set Dots - Orange (G), cut:

-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 291 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 27^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.

## From the Stripe - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 49 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 45 " x 49 " back.


## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 103 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9" x $103 / 4 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 12 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure $101 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 rectangles total.

2. Sew together (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square and (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.
3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$

4. Sew together (1) $11 / 4$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $3^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E square, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip and (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, in that order from left to right. to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 strip.
5. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 4 strip to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 strip.

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6. Sew (1) Unit 1 rectangle to each side of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.

7. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two strip (Fig. 7).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout [Fig. 8] while assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew (1) Block One rectangle to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two strip to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $11 / 2 \times 29 \times 1 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 271 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 311 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{11 / 4 " \times 29 " F a b r i c ~ F ~ s t r i p ~ t o ~ t h e ~ t o p ~}{\text { x }}$ and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 33 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 37 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.

Mini Dots - Orange (C)

$5 / 8$ yard Tossed Giraffes - Black (Backing \#2)

## You will also need:

- Fiber fill


## Pillow Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the Large Blocks - Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (2) 9 " $\times 103 / 4$ " rectangles, (1) centered on the hedgehog and (1) centered on the giraffe.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $103 / 4 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x 12 " strips.

From the Mini Dots - Orange (C)

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

Tossed Hedgehog - Gray (D)

- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) $21 / 2 " \times 18 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips.

Tossed Giraffes - Black (E)

- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.


## Tossed Hedgehog - Gray (Back \#1)

-(1) $181 / 2$ " square.
Tossed Giraffes - Black (Back \#2)
-(1) $181 / 2$ " square.

## Pillows Assembly

15. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 103 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $9 " \times 10^{3 / 4}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 9). Trim the unit to measure $101 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make a second Unit 6 rectangle.
