



## SUN TOLERANT HOSTAS FOR ZONE 5

Subtitle: Hostas that tolerate four hours of morning sun without excessive TLC;  
but may show some burning in dry conditions

Hostas are the stars of the shade garden. But what do you do if you love hostas but your garden gets four hours of morning sun? You can still grow hostas! Try growing some of these hostas:

Note: Hostas grown in higher light conditions need more moisture and should not be allowed to dry out.
