## Supplies needed:

- Fabric Background: 24.5" square ½ yard (if pieced) ¾ yard (if un-pieced)
- Dresden Neighborhood pattern by Persimon Dreams
- 1/2 yard Lite Paper-backed fusible web (Steam-a-Seam/Heat-n-Bond)
- 1/4 yard Heavy Paper-backed fusible web (Steam-a-Seam/Heat-n-Bond)
- Dresden Plate Ruler or Template
- Super-fine sharpie marker
- Paper scissors
- Piecing thread
- Decorative or Specialty thread
- Small cutting mat and rotary cutter
- Small iron and pressing surface

Note: Personal pressing mats must have hard back surface, and not allow any heat to go through to the table underneath

- Basic sewing supplies including scissors and pins
- Sewing Machine in good working order, with power cord, foot petal, manual, 1/4" foot and new needle

- Rulers 3-1/2" by 12-1/2" and 6" by 1"
- Rotating cutting mat
- Needles for Decorative and Specialty threads
- Open-toe or applique foot
- Glue stick
- Fray Check
- Backing and batting: 26" square
