Kit from instructor: \$20 paid to instructor in class by cash or check
This kit will be provided to save individuals the expense of buying expensive art supplies in quantities beyond what will be needed in class. It will include:

- Mechanical pencil, HB or B lead
- Eraser
- 1" x 12" clear, flat ruler with 1/8" grid
- Fine-tip Sharpie
- Permanent marker for use on the template plastic (better than a Sharpie and special ordered from the UK; if available.)
- 3 sheets of 8.5" x 11" vellum paper with 8 squares/inch grid. Instructor will have larger size for classroom use.
- 1 sheet template plastic
- 2 sheets 8.5" x 11" vellum for tracing. Instructor will have larger size for classroom use.

Use of instructor's supplies such as colored pencils, larger vellum grid paper, and larger and smaller gridded rulers.
