Create some fun for Christmas or throughout the Winter with simple foundation paper piecing (FPP) blocks.

Supplies needed:

- Mary Hertel's SEW A WINTER WOODLAND CHRISTMAS book
- Sewing Machine in good working order, with power cord, foot petal, manual, 1/4" foot and new needle
- Thread for piecing 50 to 60 weight to match your fabric choices
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Add a Quarter Ruler
- A package of Carol Doak newsprint to print the patterns on.
- Flat head straight pins (thinner is good)
- Fabric scissors and paper scissors
- Seam ripper
- Scotch tape
- Glue stick
- Small cutting mat
- Personal pressing mat and small iron –

Note: Personal pressing mats must have hard back surface, and not allow any heat to go through to the table underneath

Fabrics:

1/4 yard of 5 coordinating fabrics for pinwheel blocks and squares (not fat quarters)

1/4 yard of contrasting fabrics for pinwheel blocks (not Fat quarter)

½ yard of background for paper pieced blocks (non-directional fabric is best)

2/3 yard for backing 1/3 yard for binding

Batting: 1 rectangle 21" x 40"

Assorted scraps:

For the Truck and Snowman: You will be making two of this block.

To be safe, provide ½ yard of red (for the truck) 9" x 11" piece each of black, and green or any color you are going to make the scarf Scrap of orange for the carrot Black embroidery floss
