Techniques to Learn:

- Marking
- Basting
- Hand quilting
- Big Stitch quilting

Supplies:

Available in the Shop red items not carried in RMQM shop

- Book: Hand Quilting Techniques for Farmhouse Style by Carolyn Forster
- Water-soluble marker
- Chalk marking pencil for light fabric such as blue or pink with Pencil sharpener Or Sewline with leads
- 6 x 24-inch ruler with ¼ inch markings at a minimum
- Pincushion
- Thimble of your choice (metal is preferred – middle finger is often preferred)
- Small scissors for hand work
- Needle grabber
- Needle threader if desired
- Needles
 - Between quilting needles size 7 to 10
 - Sharps needles in various sizes
- Small muslin sample to quilt about 20 X 20 inch (with cotton batting and backing that is 2 inches bigger on each side than the front)
- Embroidery floss (any color)
- Hand Quilting cotton thread (Rita will provide some for purchase)
- Perle cotton (size 8) any color
- Thread softener such as beeswax or thread conditioner
- Basting pins (safety pins with a hook work well)
- Hoop at least 12 inches but no larger than 18 inches (Rita prefers a wooden hoop about an inch wide on a stand that will sit in your lap)
