Supplies needed:

A receipt of your purchase will be required to attend the class. If you haven't purchased before you come on the 30th – we can show you how to purchase it that day – but purchase must be confirmed to attend the class.
- Sashiko Thread
- Sashiko needles – assorted sizes, long for beginners – if small eye you might want a needle threader
- Small Ruler about 3" x 9"
- Piece of Sashiko fabric for creating your pattern on
- Piece of denim about 6" x 6"
- Snippers
- Chalk pencil and pencil sharpener
- Sashiko Thimble – palm of hand style – or we will create one – bring a dime, a nickle and a penny
- A piece of cardboard from cereal box or similar –6 x 8
