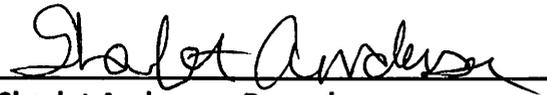
Rob also stated that they had an emergency meeting last night with the fire department and have decided to cancel the Salmon Fry this year with everything going on.
