

Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held April 4, 2018, at 8:06 pm at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:

Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Council Member Ogborn and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Scout Troop 145.

Council Member Bourne made a motion to approve the agenda. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was approval of the minutes.

A motion was made by Council Member Bourne to approve the minutes from March 21, 2018. A second was made by Council Member Ogborn with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.

Mayor Miller introduced Resolution, R-18-02, Emergency Chain of Command.

The first item under new business was to vote on the surplus property which is the first responder/squad from the fire department.

A motion was made by Council Member Bourne that we surplus the fire department squad. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was to vote on the wastewater change order number eight as discussed in the work session. He asked if there was any further discussion.

A motion was made by Council Member Marble that we approve change order number eight. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller stated the next item was the financial review and stated that it looks like we are in a good position coming into budget talks. He also stated that we will present the tentative budgets for 2018-2019 at the first meeting in May.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda is the approval of the coding for accounts payable and payroll and utility account adjustments.

Council Member Bingham made a motion to approve the coding for payroll and accounts payable and utility account adjustments. A second was made by Council Member Marble with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Under miscellaneous, Council Member Bourne asked if north main was all done. Mayor Miller replied that all the construction was done and just a few barricades need to be picked up and the speed limit signs uncovered.

Kache Johnson from Troop 145 asked how long it would be until the roads were all done and the plant was built. Tyson Knudsen from Cascade Earth Sciences replied the roads are all done and that construction will start on the plant in early 2019 and will take about nine months to complete.

Council Member Bourne made a motion to adjourn at 8:19 pm. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.
