**Mayor Pro-Temp Johnsen called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Council Member Bourne and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Bingham.**

**Mayor Pro-Temp Johnsen stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes.**

**Council Member Perry suggested that in the ad we put 'as is' and that they have to arrange for it to be moved.**

**Mayor Pro-Temp Johnsen stated the next item on the agenda was the financial review and asked if anyone had any questions. There were none.**

**The next item on the agenda was the reports of officers, boards, and committees.**
