

**Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held May 20, 2020, at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:**

**Mayor Miller called the meeting to order at 8:15 pm. Zed Rajan gave the invocation over the phone and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Marble.**

**Mayor Miller stated that we ran out of time for reports in the work session so we will do those after new business and asked for a motion to approve the agenda.**

**Council Member Ogborn made a motion to approve the amended agenda. A second was made by Council Member Marble with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Bourne to approve the minutes from March 18, 2020. A second was made by Council Member Munns with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.**

**Mayor Miller stated the first item under new business was to vote to accept the tentative budgets for 2020-2021.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Munns to approve the tentative budgets. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item under new business is to approve the Municipal Wastewater Planning Program Annual Report for 2019.**

**Council Member Marble made a motion to approve the Municipal Wastewater Planning Program Annual Report for 2019. A second was made by Council Member Ogborn with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated we would do the reports now and stated he had nothing further to report on the sewer.**

**Council Member Ogborn asked Lanette Sorensen if she had anything to report on emergency preparedness. She didn't have anything to report.**

**Fire Chief Rob Johnson reported they burned down a house and hopefully in about three weeks they could burn down the one for the city.**

**Matt Cutler reported that there won't be any city sports until fall. He reported that several groups are using the park for practices. There are games through other leagues that are responsible to follow the state guidelines.**

**Matt also reported he has been working on reports, budgets and they just finished crack sealing one neighborhood.**

**Council Member Marble stated that there has been some activity with planning and zoning but we haven't met for a bit. He stated that the Capeners are still trying to do something behind the old grade school and have submitted a subdivision on West Factory by the Udy's house. Mayor Miller added that the Capeners have also applied for a building permit to remodel the old grade school into apartments.**

**Tate Atkin reported that the library started curbside pick-up this week and they will be opening back up on June 1<sup>st</sup>. He also reported on a couple of grants they have received.**

**Council Member Bourne reported that Covid-19 messed with the beautification plans she had. She asked to have a note put on the water bills looking for volunteers for the Beautification Committee.**

**Police Chief Fertig reported that we are having some issues with Airbnb's and he will have bids soon for a new police vehicle that is to be rotated.**

**Mayor Miller stated that he would like council members to talk to the council members or department heads of a specific budget if they have questions before the next meeting so they will have time to look into the questions and make the meeting more productive.**

**Council Member Bourne brought up that she had a hunter's safety class last week and noticed that there were several scratches in the floor upstairs from a table that didn't have rubber caps on it and a couple of chairs that were in bad shape. She suggested that all the tables and chairs be checked.**

**Council Member Marble also added that his home is for sale and will be building a new one east of the hospital.**

**Mayor Miller asked if there were any financial or budget questions. There were none.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda is the approval of the coding for accounts payable and payroll and utility account adjustments.**

**Council Member Bingham made a motion to approve the coding for payroll and accounts payable and utility account adjustments. A second was made by Council Member Munns with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**
