

Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held June 5, 2019, at 8:01 p.m. at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:

Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. Council Member Bingham gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Stay.

Council Member Bingham made a motion to approve the agenda. A second was made by Council Member Stay with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was approval of the minutes.

A motion was made by Council Member Bingham to approve the minutes from April 17, 2019, and May 15, 2019. A second was made by Council Member Stay with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.
