

**Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held June 7, 2017, at 8:05 pm at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:**

**Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Council Member Perry and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Marble.**

**A motion to approve the agenda was made by Council Member Bourne. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes.**

**Council Member Bourne made a motion to approve the minutes from May 17, 2017. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. Council Member Perry asked about the billboard and the garbage contract. Matt replied that we have not heard back from them and that the certified letter we sent was never picked up so it came back. The mayor asked Matt to get the contact info to Sharlet to call and tell them that they cannot use the billboard until they communicate with us and that it is private property. He said if that didn't work then we would have the city attorney send them a letter. Sharlet stated that she emailed the garbage contract to the city attorney and after reviewing it he had some questions that she needed to get back with him on but for now he didn't think we could get out of the contract.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was to vote to approve the change order number three that they all have a copy of and would entertain a motion on.**

**Council Member Perry made a motion that we accept change order number three on our sewer system for \$48,979.04. Mayor Miller stated to clarify this is change order number three dated May 30, 2017, which is a decrease by 48,979.04. A second was made by Council Member Bourne with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the second item under new business was the approval of \$70,000 to replace the water lines in the four blocks that are on the map they have in front of them.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Marble that we approve \$70,000 for the water department to do upgrades in noted areas on the map. A second was made by Council Member Perry with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller noted this would be a 2017-2018 project.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the financial review and that he thinks we have spent a sufficient amount of time on that in the work session and asked if there were any further questions. There were none.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda is the approval of the coding for accounts payable and payroll and utility account adjustments.**

**Council Member Marble made a motion to approve the coding for payroll and accounts payable and utility account adjustments with the noted changes. A second was made by Council Member Perry with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Under miscellaneous, Mayor Miller asked Sharlet to announce who has filed to run for office. Sharlet stated that we have two four council member spots open and that Chuck Bingham and Roger Ogborn have applied to fill those spots. She stated we also have a four-year mayor office open and Todd Miller and Linda Bourne have filed for the position.**

**Council Member Bourne made a motion to adjourn at 8:15 pm. A second was made by Council Member Marble with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**
