**Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Council Member Marble and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Johnsen.**

**A motion to approve the agenda was made by Council Member Bourne. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes.**

**Council Member Bourne made a motion to approve the minutes from June 21, 2017. A second was made by Council Member Johnsen with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.**

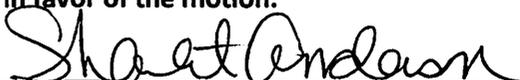
