

**Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held August 5, 2020, at 8:12 p.m. at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:**

**Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. Council Member Ogborn gave the invocation and Council Member Bingham led the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**A motion to approve the agenda was made by Council Member Ogborn. A second was made by Council Member Bourne with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes.**

**Council Member Bourne made a motion to approve the minutes from June 17, 2020, and July 8, 2020. A second was made by Council Member Munns with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.**

**Mayor Miller stated the first item under new business was a vote to accept or deny the Ashlee Meadows LLC annexation petition.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Marble to accept the Ashlee Meadows LLC annexation petition. A second was made by Council Member Ogborn with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the second item under new business was a vote to move forward or not with the mayor and city council pay increases.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Bingham to not move forward with the mayor and city council pay increases. A second was made by Council Member Munns with Council Members Bingham, Munns, Marble, and Ogborn voting in favor of the motion and Council Member Bourne voting against the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the motion passes to not move forward at this time.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the financial review and asked if there were any questions. The city recorder stated that she forgot to send the budget reports out.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda is the approval of the coding for accounts payable and payroll and utility account adjustments.**

**Council Member Ogborn made a motion to approve the coding for payroll and accounts payable and utility account adjustments. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was reports of officers, boards and committees. He stated that we got great news yesterday from the department of environmental quality. They have issued our construction permit for the sewer plant finally. He also stated that we just need to finish up the funding package and we will be ready to start.**

**Emergency Management Director, Lanette Sorensen, stated that we had an estimated 17 projects we were working on with the CARES Act funding. Six are completed, eight are partially completed and three are on hold until we get additional funding.**

Fire Chief Rob Johnson stated that they have had someone apply for the department that works in Garland but lives in Cache Valley. In the past, they have said they have to live within a certain distance and wanted to know what the council thought about it. Mayor Miller said it is fine as long as their bylaws allow it.

Council Member Munns reported that we are doing fall soccer registration and the deadline is August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Council Marble reported we have a planning and zoning meeting next week with a lot of things on the agenda so we should be seeing somethings happening.

Council Member Bourne reported that Fred Christensen has contacted her and would like to be done as the Garland City representative on the mosquito abatement board at the end of the year so she will start going to the meetings starting in January.

Police Chief Kurt Fertig reported that the new radar trailer they have gives really good data. He stated that they had a citizen complaint of speeding on 1400 South. The speed limit is 30 mph but the signs are missing east of the river bottoms. They discussed the data from the trailer and if the speed limit should be raised. Mayor Miller stated he is the one that brought up that they might want to consider raising the speed limit. His recommendation was going to be to change it to 40 mph. A discussion ensued and it was decided to set the speed limit to 35 mph east of the river bottoms.

Chief Fertig also brought up the crosswalk south of the high school and asked if it would be alright if Tremonton City painted the portion of the curb red before it to make the crosswalk more visible that was in Garland. The mayor and council said that would be great if they painted it.

Council Member Bingham reported that the gym floor was done and it looks very nice. He also stated that it would be closed for any use until September.

Council Member Bingham made a motion to adjourn at 9:00 p.m. A second was made by Council Member Munns with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.
