

Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held November 1, 2017, at 8:07 pm at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:

Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Council Member Perry and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Marble.

Council Member Marble made a motion that we approve the agenda for the 1st of November 2017. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes.

Council Member Bourne made a motion to approve the minutes from October 18th. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.

Mayor Miller stated under new business was the vote on the Jimmy and Lacey Munns Subdivision Final Plat and asked if there were any questions.

A motion was made by Council Member Bourne that we approve the Jimmy and Lacey Munns Subdivision Plat. A second was made by Council Member Perry with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

The next item under new business is to swear in Chad Hayman. Chief Chad Soffe introduced the new part-time officer and stated that he has worked for Tremonton City for thirteen years and Washington Terrace before that. He stated that he has a lot of experience and wants to come and help us out part-time and they are happy to have him as part of their team.

The city recorder administered the Oath of Office for Chad Hayman.

Mayor Miller stated the final item under new business was to vote on a variance for the hours of Sofa's Corner for New Year's Eve.

Council Member Marble made a motion that we make a one-time variance for Sofa's Corner allowing them to be open on Sunday, December 31 for extended hours for New Year's 2017 into January 1, 2018, with the normal deadline of last sales at 1 am and closing at 2 am. A second was made by Council Member Perry with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Miller stated motion passes.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the financial review and asked if there were any questions. There were none.

Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda is the approval of the coding for accounts payable and payroll and utility account adjustments.

Council Member Marble made a motion to approve the coding for payroll and accounts payable and utility account adjustments. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Under miscellaneous, Mayor Miller stated that he wanted to discuss the Christmas Party and meeting dates through the end of the year. He stated that we have a meeting scheduled for November 15 and he and Chuck will be out of town for that meeting. He stated we can still meet but at this point, we don't have anything on the agenda. It was decided not to have it unless something came up. He then stated that the next meeting is scheduled for December 13th but would like to change that meeting to December 6th and have the Christmas Party on December 13th here in the gym but keeping in mind that if we don't meet on November 15th then it will be six weeks in between meetings. He commented that if we need to call an emergency later in December we can if something comes up. The council agreed to change the December meeting to the 6th and have the party on the 13th.

Council Member Bourne made a motion to adjourn at 8:18 pm. A second was made by Council Member Bingham with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.
