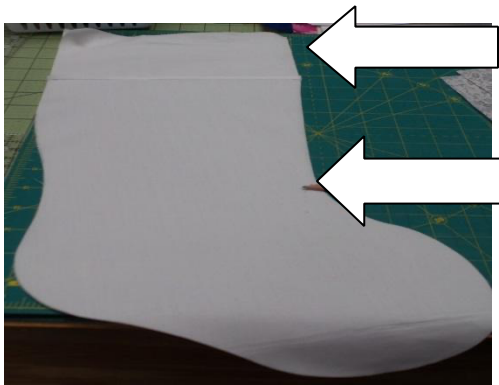




Take 2-1/2" strip and press in half, then fold each raw edge into the middle, press and stitch closed and set aside.



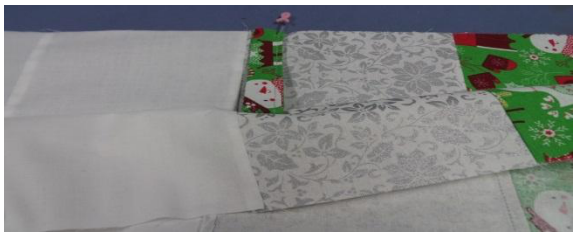
Layout your stocking and cuff, right sides up, and do the same with your lining. It is difficult to see right side on your lining, so this is an easy way to make sure you attach the cuffs correctly. Attach all 4 cuffs; 1 to each side of lining and 1 to each side of stocking. Press one lining cuff up and one lining cuff down. Press the stocking the same way.



With right sides together, stitch lining from top of cuff, to the 2nd arrow – the top of the curve. Do the same for the stocking.



Stitch the top of the cuff lining, to the top of the stocking lining, right sides together (RST)



Pin your tab near the seam between the lining and the stocking. Tab needs to be folded in half, with raw edges out. Pin in place. When sewing, backstitch over the tab for additional strength.



Fold lining and stocking so that they lay on top of each other. One long unit. Continue your 1/4" seam all the way around the stocking, but leave the lining OPEN about 1-1/2" – 2" TO TURN YOUR STOCKING. Once sewn, turn stocking right side out, stitch lining closed (hand or machine) and press.
