

Head Scarf

1. Cut 27" square of prewashed soft cotton fabric.
2. With wrong sides together, fold and press on diagonal to form triangle.
3. Cut 12" x 9" cotton batting (no polyester). Fold in half length-wise.
4. With wrong sides of fabric together, insert folded batting into fold of triangle, centering it.
5. Fabric triangle is right side out. Mark ends of batting strip. With walking presser foot, on top of batting, beginning one inch from fold, sew three channels each one inch apart.
6. Turn the triangle wrong side out. Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, sew front to back leaving five to six inches so you can pull it right side out. Press.
7. Top stitch around triangle edges.

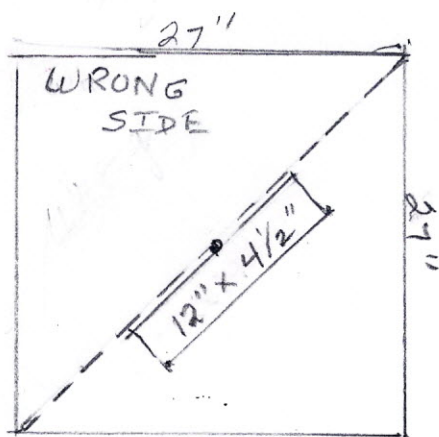
