Entry Information – Each quilt or item must have a separate entry form.

- There are no restrictions on item size, shape or technique. No previous entries in a Yakima Valley Quilt show are allowed.
- Due to space availability, there is a limit of 6 entries per person. This does not include Friendship Group Quilts, Guild Projects Display, or Challenge Quilts.

- Registration opens February 12, 2024
- Entry deadline is April 18, 2024
- You will select a location for your entry to be displayed. Options are: Main Show, Friendship Group, Guild Projects Display, To Bee or Not to B Challenge, or Wearable Art.
 - The Main Show Area is where most quilts are displayed. All main floor quilts must be finished quilts and will be displayed with a hanging sleeve.
 - Friendship Groups are set up as a booth, with your confirmed group creating a display to show all of the group's projects in one space. If your entry is to go in a friendship booth, you will be asked to identify which one. Your group is responsible for setting up the display.
 - The Guild Projects Display category is the area that promotes our Guild. These are quilts or projects that YVQG members have created together throughout the year. These may include individual lotto blocks, an unfinished quilt from a class, Secret Sister or December gift exchange items, Fair or Shoebox quilts, or the Summer Challenge projects.
 - This year's Challenge quilt is 2 Bee or Not to B. Please see YVQG's show webpage at: https://media.rainpos.com/5629/To_bee_or_not_to_b.pdf for complete information.
 - New for 2024 is the category Wearable Art. If you are registering a quilted garment, please register here so we will know to have appropriate display space.

- When you register online, you should receive a confirmation e-mail with your entry information. Please print this out. If you do not receive a confirmation, please contact Lois Dean at 509-833-7362 (text or call). After you hit the “submit” button, you should see a screen that says “Thank You” and has a large green check mark. Again,
- if you do not see this screen, your entry may not have been completed, so please contact Lois.

Your submission has been received.

- Each quilt must have a 4” hanging sleeve on the back. The top of the hanging sleeve must be placed 90” from the bottom of the quilt if your quilt is longer than 90”.
- Each quilt must have a label with the exhibitor’s name, address and phone number sewn to the back. (This info may be printed on the hanging sleeve.)
- Be sure to accurately indicate size of quilt on registration form.

- Bring your quilts on drop off day: Wednesday May 15th 10am to 6:00pm to the Yakima Valley Convention Center at 10 N. 8th Street, Yakima, WA.
- When bringing your quilts on drop off day, please fold your quilt so that the bottom LEFT side of the BACK of the quilt is facing out. This is where we will secure your information.
- Your claim form will be given to you when your items are received. You must present this form at the time of pick up.
- Pick up is Saturday May 18th 6:00pm to 7:00pm. Quilts will not be released before that time or without a claim check.
- If you make arrangements for someone else to pick up your entries, be sure to give them your claim check.
- The Yakima Valley Quilters’ Guild is not responsible for loss or damage. Check with your homeowner’s insurance for coverage of your entries while displayed.
- Be assured we will do our best to protect all entries in the quilt show.

The Yakima Valley Quilters’ Guild thanks you for participating in our show and sharing your quilts for all to see. Your beautiful quilts and projects are what make our show such a success.
