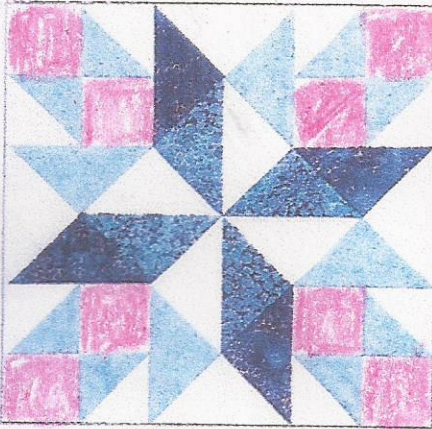

White Tone-on-Tone

- 4 squares (A) 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈"
- 2 squares (B) 3³/₄" x 3³/₄"
- 16 squares (C) 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂"
- 1 square 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" ☒ (D)



Unit 1

Make 8 from A's

Light Teal Tone-on-Tone

- 4 squares (A) 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈"
- 1 square 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" ☒ (D)



Unit 2

Make 4 from B's

Medium Teal Print

- 2 squares (B) 3³/₄" x 3³/₄"

Yellow Tone-on-Tone

- 16 squares (C) 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂"

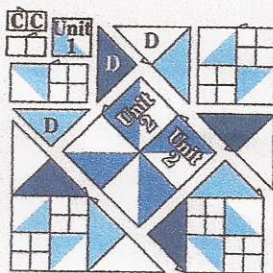
Dark Blue Tone-on-Tone

- 1 square 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" ☒ (D)

It's helpful to starch the fabric before cutting the D's to stabilize the bias edges.

Pair the white A's with the light teal A's to make 8 Triangle-Square unit 1's. Make 4 unit 2's using white B's and medium teal B's.

Sew the patches and units together as shown to complete the block. 🧩



Block Assembly

For this months block, please substitute red Print, solid or tone-on-tone for the yellow 1 1/2 in. squares. Substitute a light blue for the Light teal and a medium blue for medium Teal squares. The dark blue remains the same For the D squares and use a white on white For the background color as specified.

Place the 2 7/8 in white squares and the 2 7/8 in light blue squares together and draw a line Diagonally across the block. Sew on both sides Of the drawn line and cut apart to form 8 half Square triangles. Sew one red and one white Square together and then sew together to make A four patch. Repeat to form 8 squares. Sew 2 light blue triangles (D) together with 2 white triangles as shown in the diagram. Sew 2 dark blue triangles (D) with white triangles as shown in the diagram. Sew the units together as shown in the diagram to construct the block.

REVISED DIRECTIONS

Please see the diagram for the placement of the red and white 4 patch blocks. This placement will create a diagonal chain across the quilt when the blocks are sewn together.

Dark blue 5 1/4 in squares, light blue 5 1/4 in Squares and white 5 1/4 in squares should be cut into 4 triangles as shown in the diagram: Not stacked and sewn together as in making quarter square triangles. (an x drawn across the square and sewing on each side of the drawn line and cut into fourths). You need to place a blue and white triangle together and sew the two together. Look at the diagram for the sewing method.
