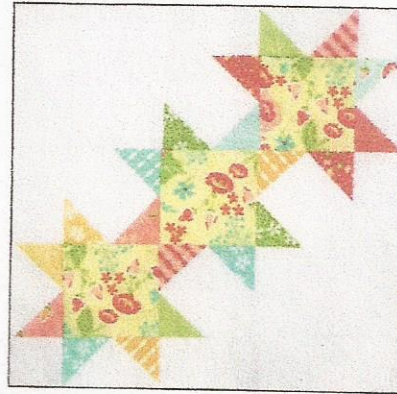

White Solid

- 4 squares (A) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 2 squares (B) 2" x 2"
- 8 rectangles (C) 2" x 3 1/2"
- 2 squares (D) 5" x 5"

Assorted Green, Peach, Teal and Yellow Prints

- 20 squares (B) 2" x 2"

Light Green Print

- 3 squares (A) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

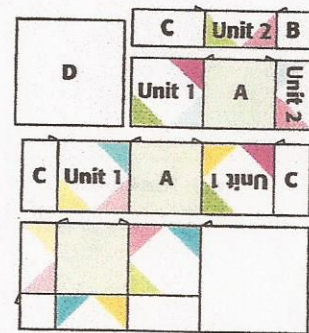


Refer to Stitch-and-Flip
in Techniques. Use the
white A's and assorted
print B's to make 4 unit 1's
as shown. Pair white C's
and assorted print B's to
make 4 unit 2's as shown.

Unit 1
Stitch & Flip
Make 4

Unit 2
Stitch & Flip
Make 4

Sew the units and patches together as shown to complete the block.
