

October lotto block

MEMORY

- White
 - A: 1 5 ¼ in square cut in half diagonally twice
 - C: 4 2 7/8 in square cut in half diagonally once
 - D: 4 2 ½ in squares
- Gold
 - B: 1 4 ½ in square
 - C: 4 2 7/8 in squares cut in half diagonally once
- Dark blue
 - E: 1 5 ¼ in square cut in half diagonally twice
 - F: 8 2 7/8 in squares cut in half diagonally once
 - G: 4 2 1/2 in squares

Using a blue (E) half square triangle and 2 (C) gold quarter square triangles make a flying goose unit. Repeat to create 4 units total.

Using a white (A) half square triangle and 2 (C) blue quarter square triangles make a flying goose unit. Repeat to create 4 units total.

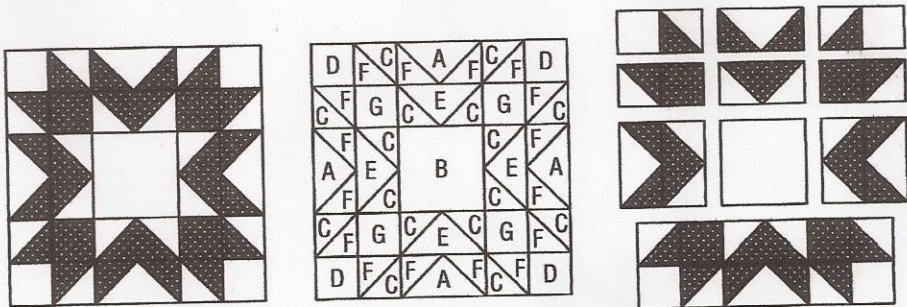
Using a white (C) triangle and a blue (F) triangle sew together to create a square. (2 ½) Repeat to create 8 squares. Sew a white (D) square to 4 of the units.

Sew a blue (G) square to each of the remaining blue/white squares.

Following the diagram, construct the block.
