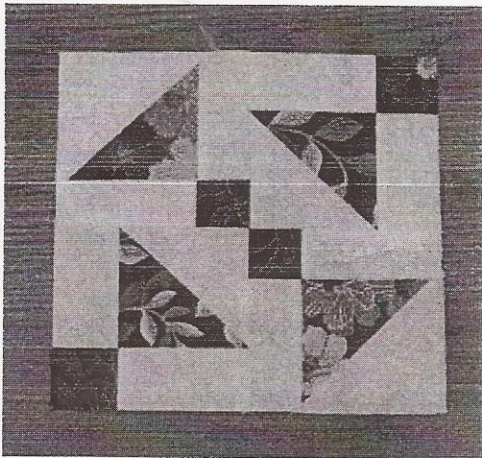


SHOOFLY QUILT BLOCK VARIATION

Due: Jan. 8th, 2020

Block finishes at 8.5" square (9" unfinished)

Fabric Colors:

Background fabric : White on White

Main fabric : Multi Tonal Patern

CUT:

White on white : 2 - 4" squares AND 4 - 3.5" squares

Main fabric : 2 - 4" squares, 1 - 3.5" square

Sewing Directions:

Mark a diagonal line on the back of the 2 - 4" white square's. Put right sides together on one white 4" square and one 4" main fabric square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the marked line on the white square. Repeat for the remaining 4" blocks. Cut on the diagonal line to make 4 - 3.5" half-square triangle blocks. Iron open pressing to the dark side. Arrange the 4 HST's with the white on white background 3.5" squares with the 3.5" main fabric in the center and the 4 HST's in each corner (See diagram 1). Sew the patches together in three row's, starting with the top row, then middle, and bottom. Iron the rows toward the white square's. Sew the three row's together, and iron. Next Cut down the center of the block, both horizontally and vertically (See diagram 2). Rotate the upper left and lower right corners 180 degrees and sew the four squares back together in a typical 4 patch block (See Diagram 3), and your done!

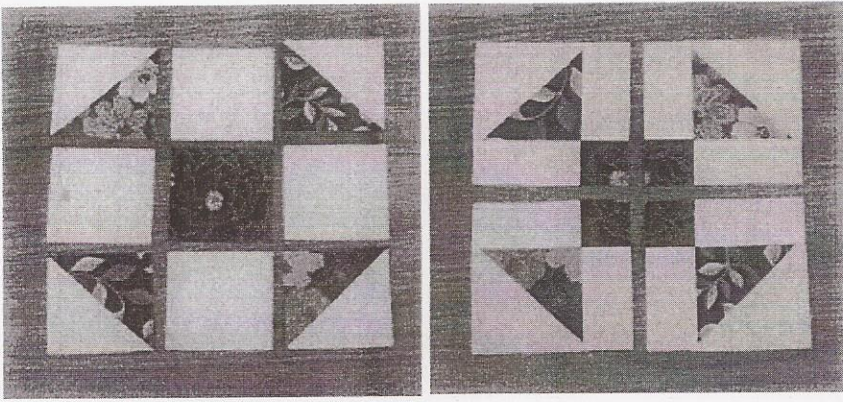
