

# Spread the Love

Foundation Paper Pieced Pattern

By Center Street Quilts

Finished Sizes: 6" x 6" and 12" x 12"



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## Before you begin:

- Basic knowledge of foundation paper piecing (FPP) is expected for this pattern.
- When you print the pattern pieces, make sure your printer is set to print at "Actual Size" or "100%" (not "Fit to page" or "Scale."). There is a one inch line on the first page of each pattern that can be used as a reference.
- The pattern pieces all include a 1/4" seam allowance (the outer solid line), and are shaded in for easy color identification. A complete diagram of the Spread the Love quilt block and the location of every pattern piece (as the block will look when it is assembled) is located on the following page. Remember that the pattern pieces will be a mirror image of the completed block.
- Shorten your stitch length to make tearing the paper easier.
- Backstitching at the beginning and end of each seam will help secure your seams and add strength as the paper is being torn away.

## Assembly Instructions

After piecing each of the individual sections, follow the guide below to assemble the quilt block:

$A + B = AB$

$C + D = CD$

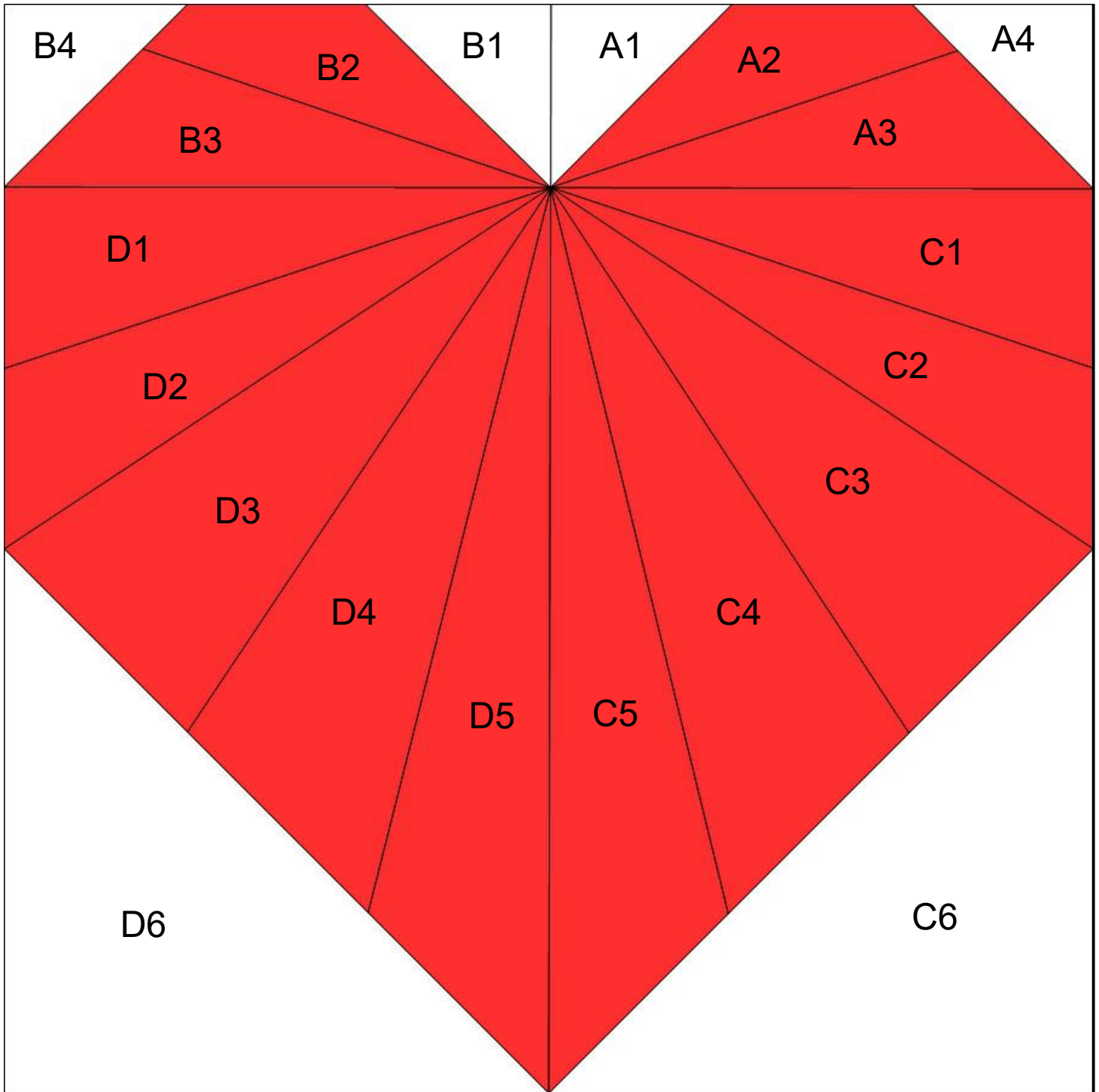
$AB + CD = ABCD$

Note: there are a lot of seams that come together in the corner where the four pattern pieces intersect. As you sew a new fabric piece on, trim the excess fabric in that corner to slightly under 1/4" away from the seam in to keep the bulk to a minimum.

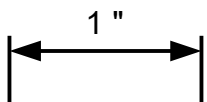
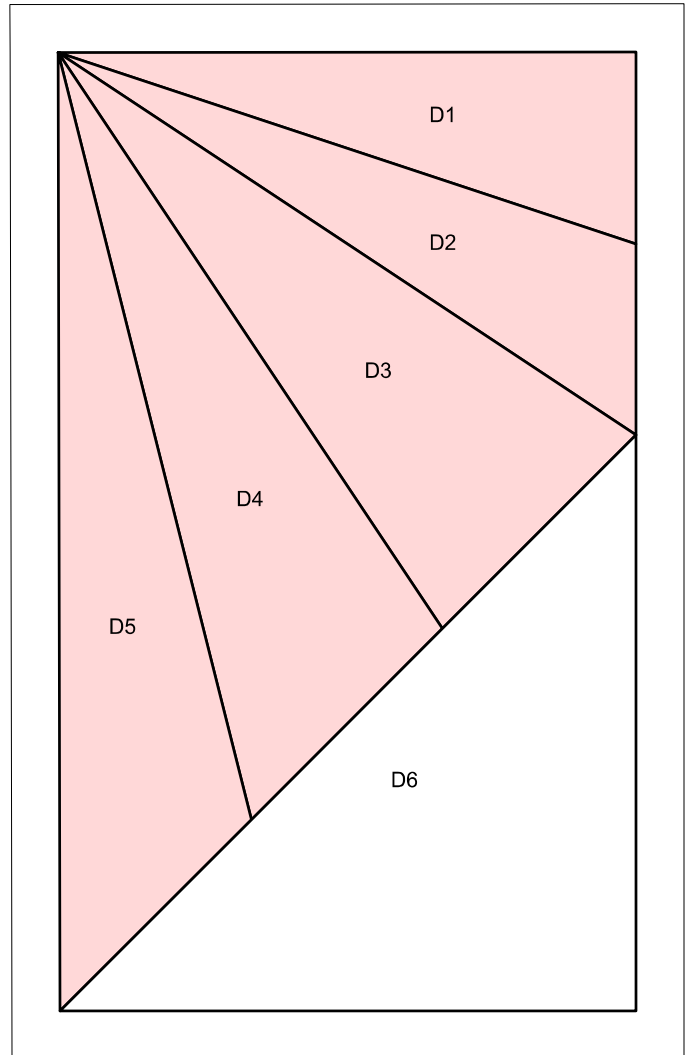
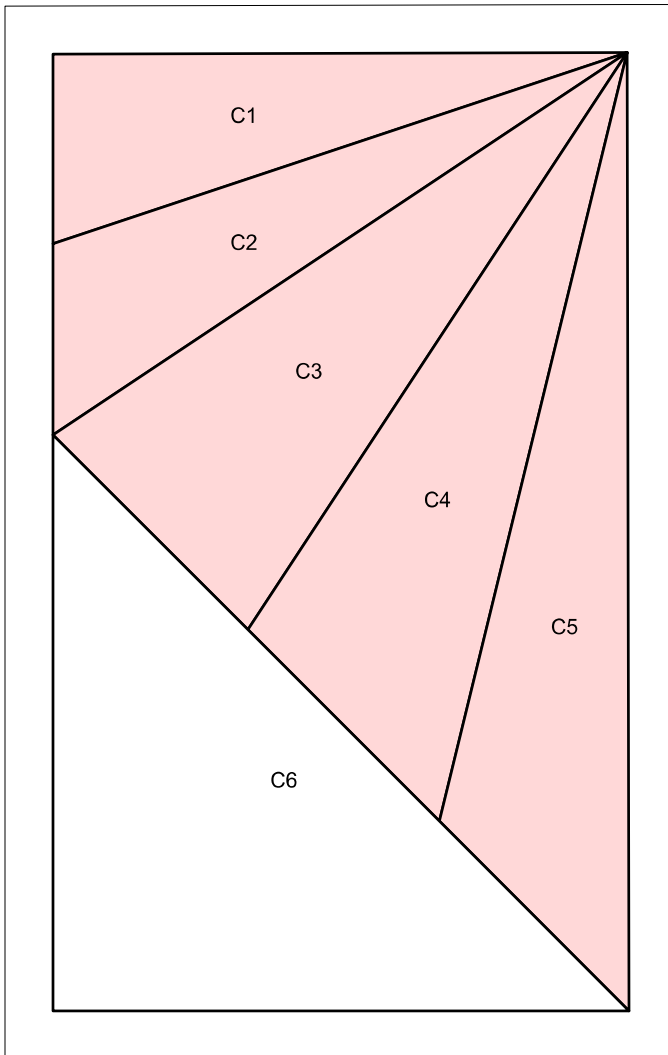
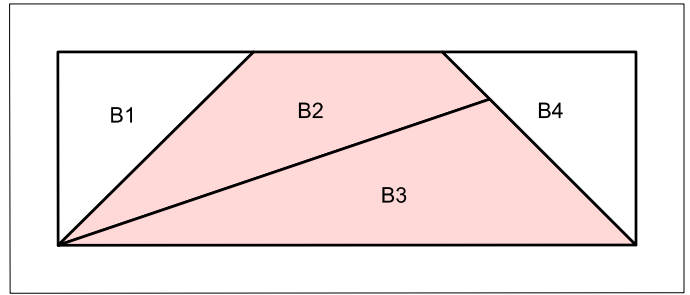
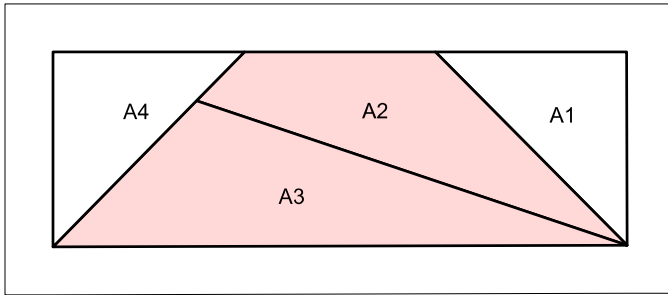
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Diagram of all pattern pieces



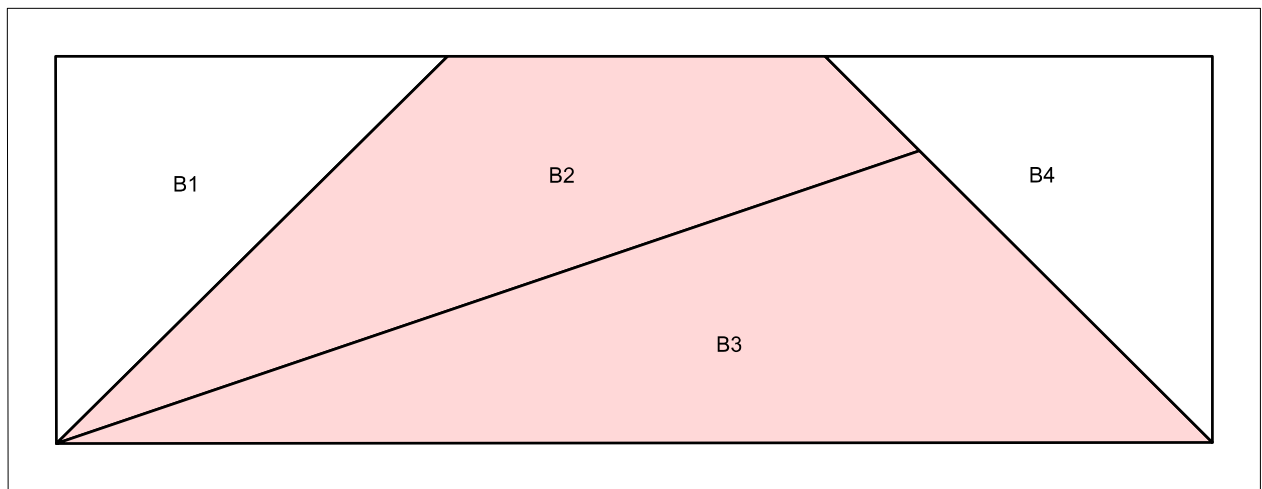
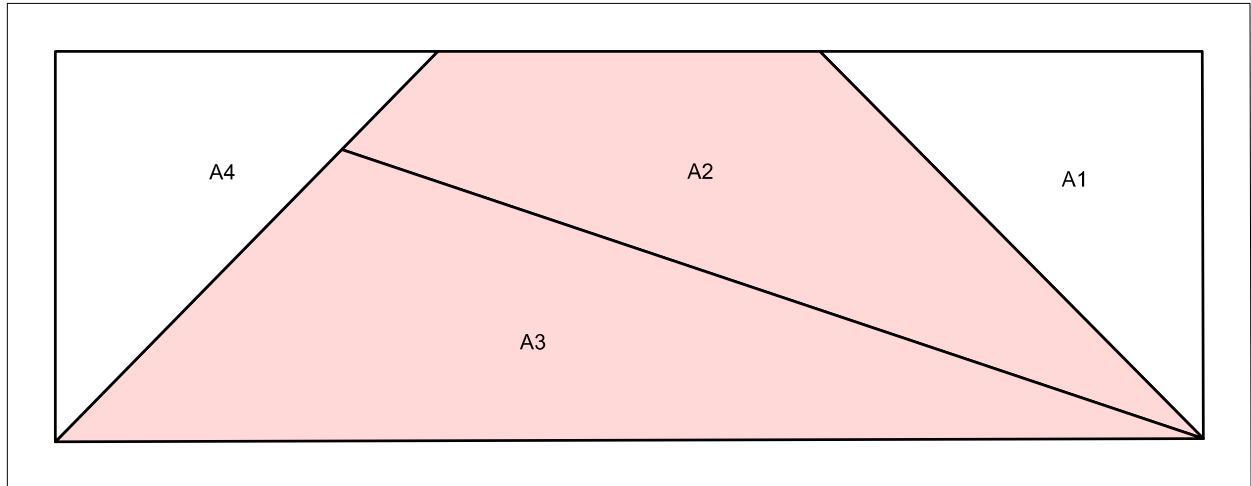
