

**Quiltmaking supply list** – Please bring all your supplies to the first class, including fabric.

1 lightweight 3 ring binder to organize papers, the smaller and lighter weight the better

**Important!** You must have a sewing machine in good working order, recently cleaned, oiled and professionally tuned. You will need to know how to thread your machine and how to wind a bobbin. Please bring your sewing machine manual to class.

Size 80/12 (for Mettler thread) or 90/14 (for Signature thread) sewing needles (universal)

Good quality thread (Mettler/Signature) to match fabric

Scissors to cut thread inexpensive is fine, thin glass head pins

A 45mm or 60 mm rotary cutter (Olf) the ones that close automatically are wonderful!

An 18 X 24 self-healing rotary mat (Olf) – don't leave in a hot car or near a heat source!!!!!!

A 6 ½" X 6 ½" acrylic ruler (Creative Grid)

A 6 ½" X 23" acrylic ruler (Creative Grid)

Fabric – the best part –

5/8 yard of dark fabric

2 yards of light fabric for blocks, inner border and sashing + ¼

5/8 yard of medium fabric

5/8 yard zinger fabric

Later on to finish your quilt. (You can delay these purchases if desired)

1 ¾ yard border fabric (can be the same as dark fabric)

Twin sized quilt batting or 67" X 82" if you buy it off a roll (cost depends on what kind you buy)

Backing fabric 3 ¾ yd

Binding ¾ yd

Size 1 quilt safety pins

Walking foot for your sewing machine

Please try to come to class with all of your supplies. However it is not wise to leave a self-healing rotary mat in a hot car. Your mat will warp and not be useful anymore. Our wonderful ladies at the store will help you with your fabric selection and answer any questions about
