

FREE PATTERN

PETIT FOUR QUILT 36" X 42"



A quick lap or baby quilt made with "charm" squares (5" squares), with two-fabric side and corner triangles as a unique frame.

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Fabric Requirements:

5" SQUARES:	36 (32 for quilt center and 4 for the side and corner triangles)
INNER BORDER (WHITE):	1/3 yd
OUTER BORDER (GREY PRINT):	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd
BACKING:	1 1/3 yd
BATTING:	40" X 45"
BINDING:	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd

PETIT FOUR QUILT

All seams are 1/4". Press seams as indicated.

Cutting Instructions:

MAIN SQUARES

From the charm pack, select thirty-two squares for the center of the quilt and set aside.

TWO-FABRIC SIDE AND CORNER TRIANGLES (charm fabrics and "inner border" fabric)

- Select four charm pack squares to cut up for the pieced side triangles:
 1. Cross-cut each square twice diagonally to end up with a total of sixteen triangles (you will need fourteen of these for the side triangles).



2. Take the two triangles not needed from the step 1 above and subcut again as shown to make two smaller triangles from each.



- From the Inner Border fabric:
Cut one strip 8 1/4" x width of fabric; sub-cut into fourteen 2" x 8 1/4" rectangles, four 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles and four 2" x 3" rectangles.

OUTER BORDER FABRIC

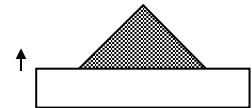
Cut four strips 5" x width of fabric.

BINDING FABRIC

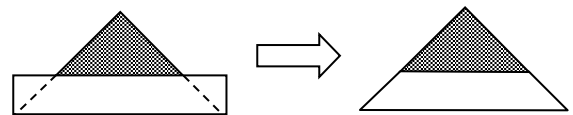
Cut five strips 2 1/4" x width of fabric.

Pieced Side Triangles/Inner Border:

1. Join each 2" x 8 1/4" "inner border" rectangle to a "charm square" triangle. Press toward the triangle. Make fourteen.

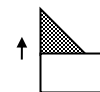


2. Trim each side triangle unit back to a triangle by following the angle with a long ruler. Cut off each extra bit of the rectangle on each side.

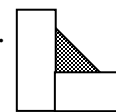


Pieced Corner Triangles/Inner Border:

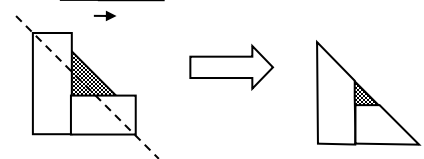
1. Join a 2" x 3" "inner border" rectangle to a "charm square small triangle". Press toward the triangle. Make four.



2. Join a 2" x 4 1/2" "inner border" rectangle to the unit above, as shown. Press toward the triangle. Make four.



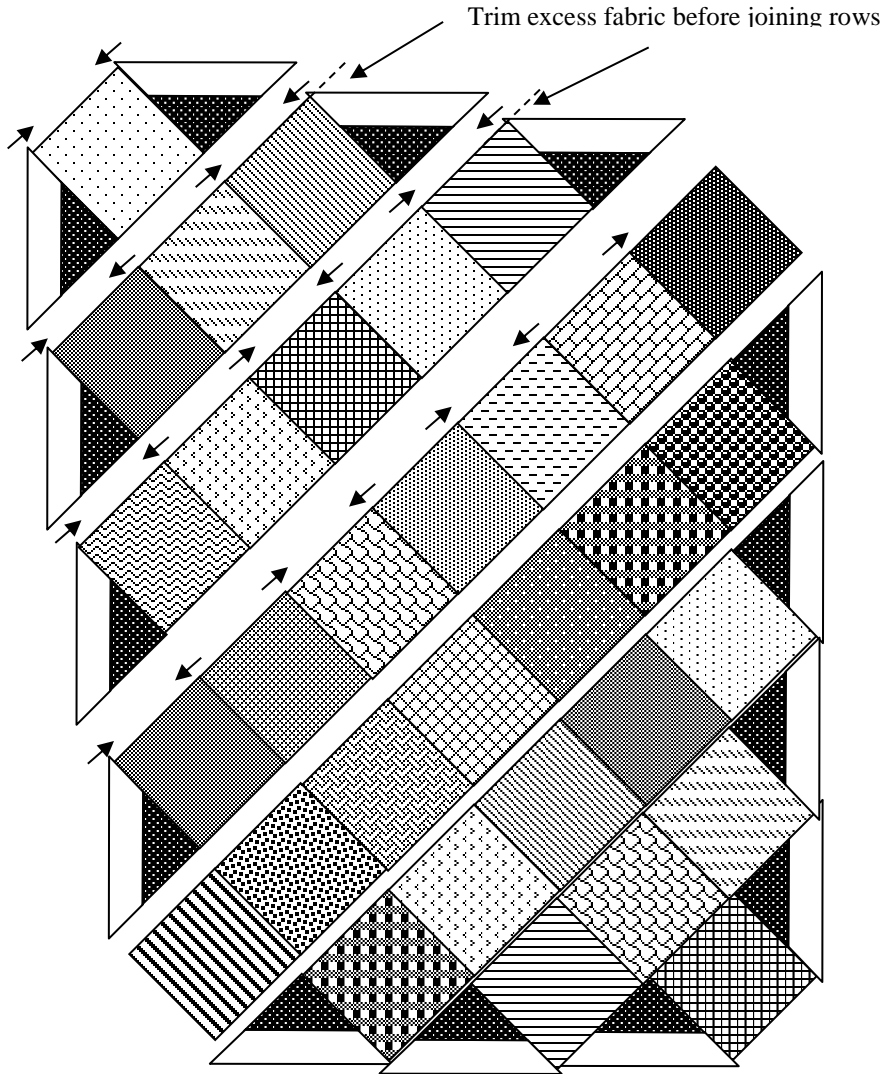
3. Trim each corner triangle unit back to a triangle with a ruler, lining up the ruler to the outside corners of the "inner border" rectangles, as shown. Discard the excess fabric.



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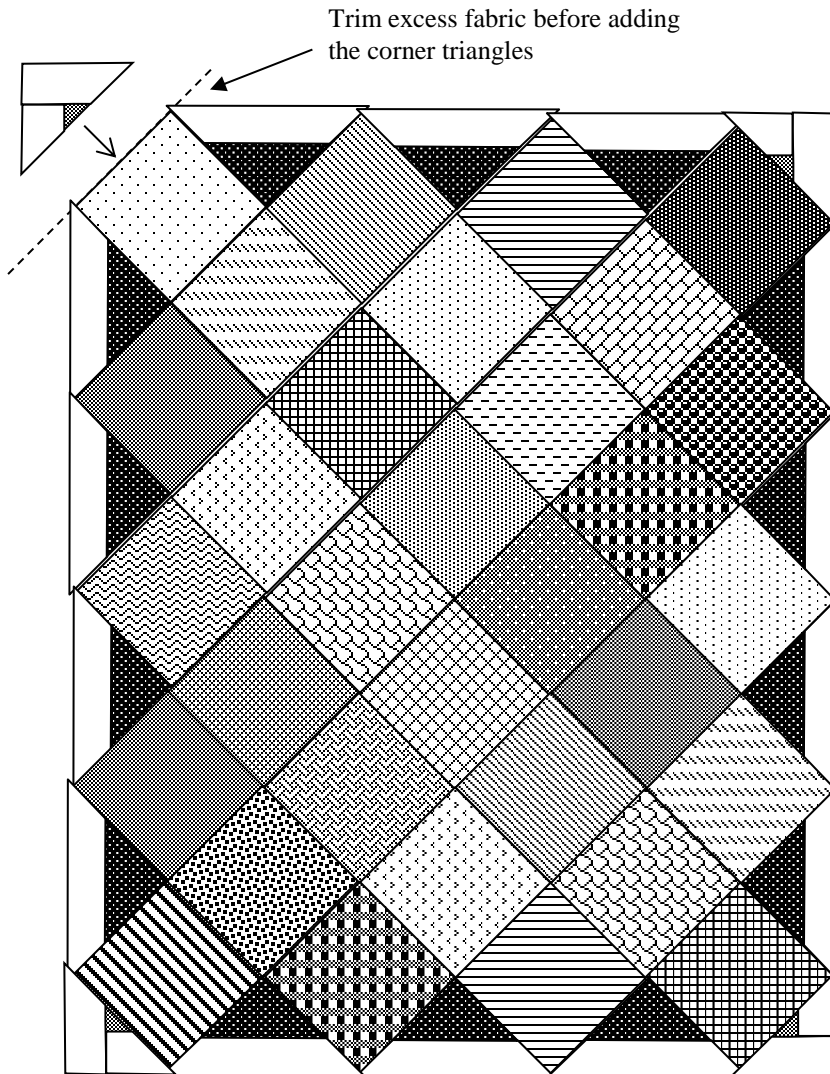
Quilt Assembly:

1. Starting in the top left corner, arrange the rows and side triangles on the diagonal, using the diagram below for reference. Trim the excess from each side triangle before joining the rows. Press seams as indicated by the short arrows.



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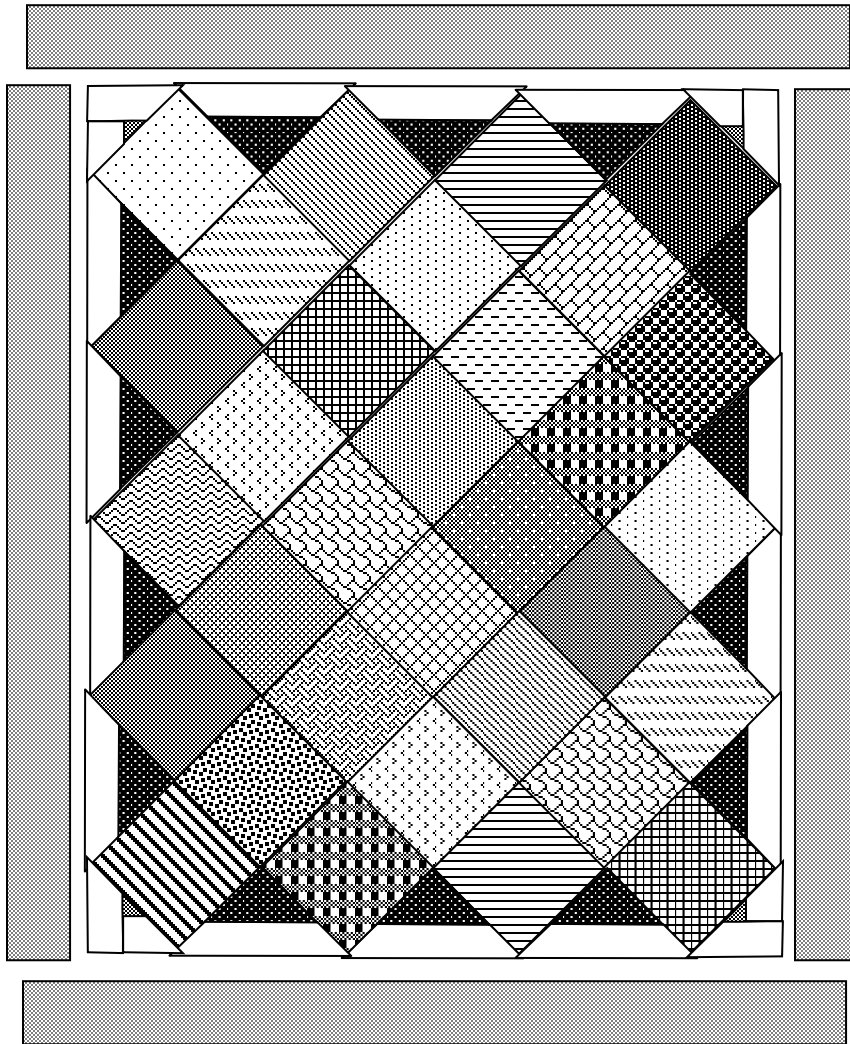
2. Trim away the excess side triangle fabric in the four corners of the quilt and attach the corner triangles. Press toward the corner triangles.



PETIT FOUR QUILT

OUTER BORDER:

Measure the quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using outer border strips 5" x WOF, Cut two 5" wide border strips to equal this measurement. Attach outer border strips to the sides of quilt. Press out toward the outer border fabric. Do the same for the top and bottom borders.



Layer and quilt. Join the binding strips end to end and attach to quilt using your preferred method.
