## HAWAIIAN CHARM QUILT 34" X 34"



This little lap quilt uses one charm pack, plus background and binding.

You can even change the applique' blocks to suit your theme!

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### Fabric Requirements:

CHARM SQUARES (5" X 5"):	40 (from assorted scraps or one charm pack)
BACKGROUND FABRIC:	1 yard
FLOWER CENTERS AND BINDING:	1/3 yard
BACKING:	1 1/8 yard
BATTING:	40" X 40"

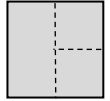
# HAWAIIAN CHARM QUILT

All seams are 1/4". Press seams as indicated.

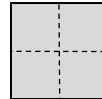
## Cutting Instructions:

### CHARM SQUARES (5" x 5" squares)

- Take thirteen charm squares and reserve for appliqué flowers.
- From twenty-two charm squares, cut one  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 5"$  rectangle and two  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$  squares.



- From five charm squares, cut four  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$  squares.



(The cutting above should yield a total of twenty-two  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 5"$  rectangles and sixty-four  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$  squares).

### BACKGROUND FABRIC

- Cut three strips  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times$  width of fabric (WOF); subcut into thirteen  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  squares and eight  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles.
- Cut two strips  $5" \times$  WOF; subcut into twenty  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 5"$  rectangles.

### FLOWER CENTERS AND BINDING FABRIC

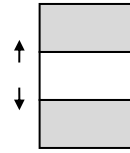
- For binding, cut four strips  $2\frac{1}{4}" \times$  width of fabric. Reserve the rest for flower center appliqués.

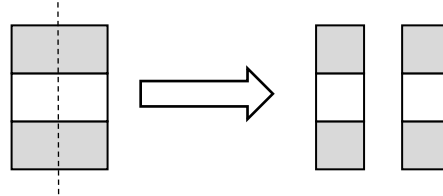
## Assembling Pieced Blocks:

1. Join a *Charm Fabric*  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$  rectangle to either side of a *Background Fabric*  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$  rectangle, as shown in the diagram.

Press toward the charm fabric rectangles. Make eight.

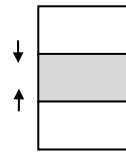


2. Cut each step 1 unit into two  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  units for a total of 16 smaller units.

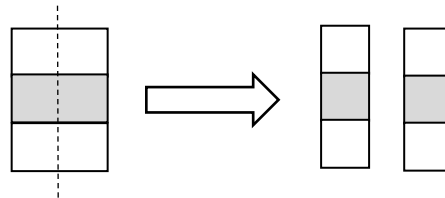


3. Join a *Background Fabric*  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$  rectangle to either side of a *Charm Fabric*  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$  rectangle, as shown in the diagram.

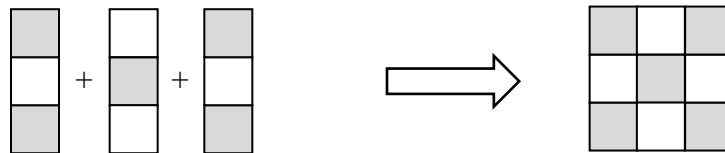
Press toward the charm fabric rectangles. Make six.



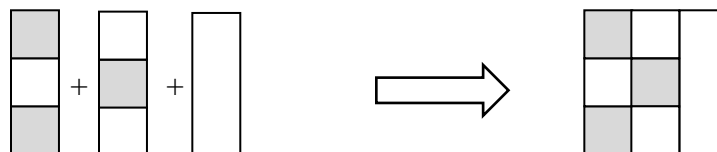
4. Cut each step 3 unit into two  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  units.



Use eight of the units from Step 2 and four of the units from Step 4 to make four nine-patch blocks:



Use eight of the units from Step 2, eight of the units from Step 4, and eight  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  background rectangles (from page 1 cutting instructions) to make eight partial nine-patch blocks:



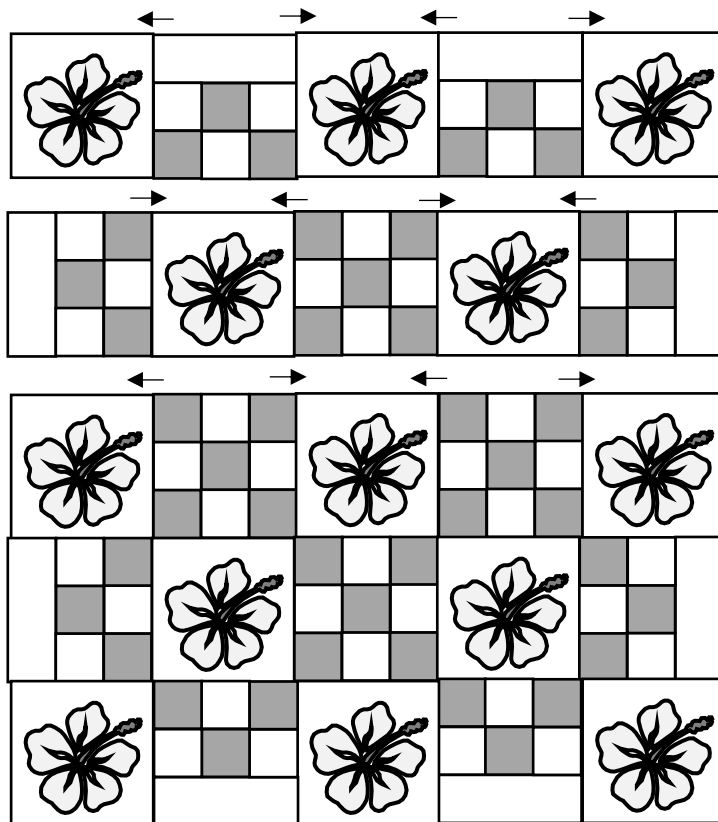

## Assembling Applique' Blocks:

1. Please read all fusible web instructions before beginning. The applique' in this quilt was done using the fusing method. You can use other applique' methods if you wish.
2. Trace the reverse of each component of the hibiscus (page 5) on the paper side of the fusible web. When they are ironed on, the pieces will face the right direction. Do this 13 times.
3. Cut fusible web approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$ " around each pattern piece. Do not cut on the traced line.
4. Place each petal set 1-5 on the wrong side of a charm square. Press according to fusible web instructions. Let cool, then cut out on the traced line. Do this with 13 charm squares.
5. Place the 13 flower centers on the wrong side of the binding/flower center fabric. Press according to fusible web instructions. Let cool, then cut each one out on the traced line.
6. Fuse a hibiscus flower and center onto each  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " background square. Blanket stitch or zigzag around the pattern pieces with coordinating threads.

## Quilt Assembly:

Using the diagram below for reference, assemble blocks into five rows of five blocks. Alternate pieced blocks with the appliqué blocks. The nine-patch blocks will be in the center of the quilt and the partial nine-patch blocks will be on the outside. Press seams as indicated by the arrows.



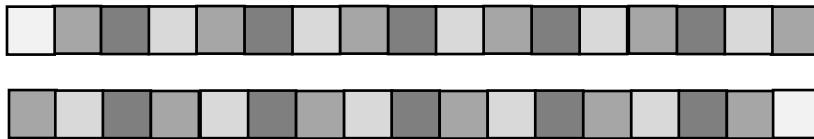

## Pieced Border:

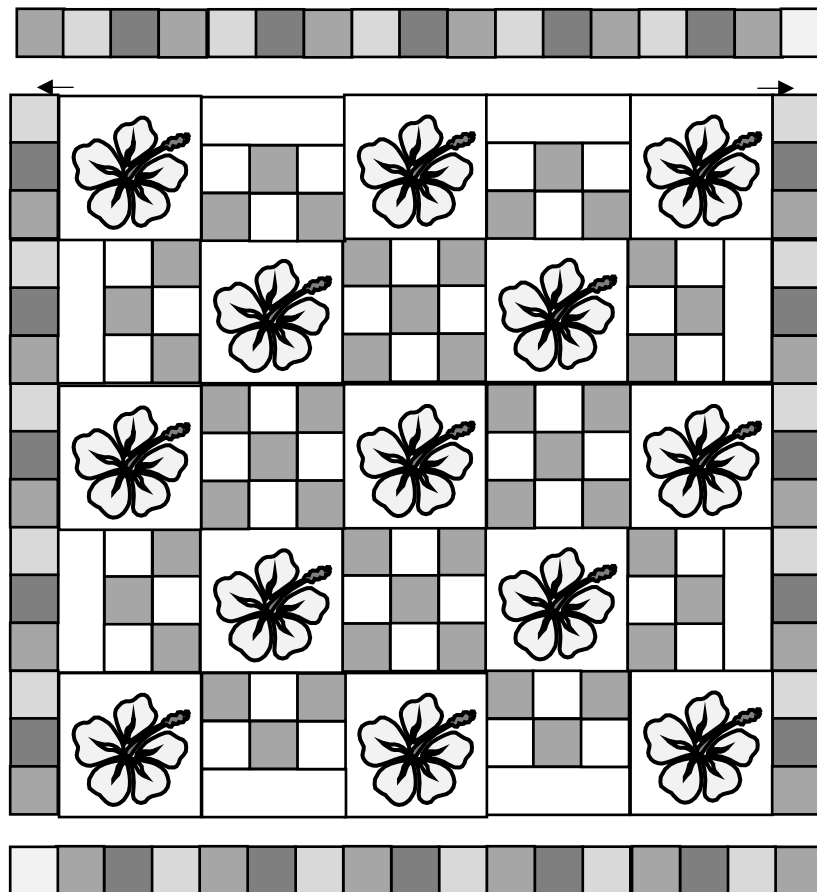
Using the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, make two side borders. Each will be made with fifteen  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



With the remaining  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, make the top and bottom borders. Each will be made with seventeen  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

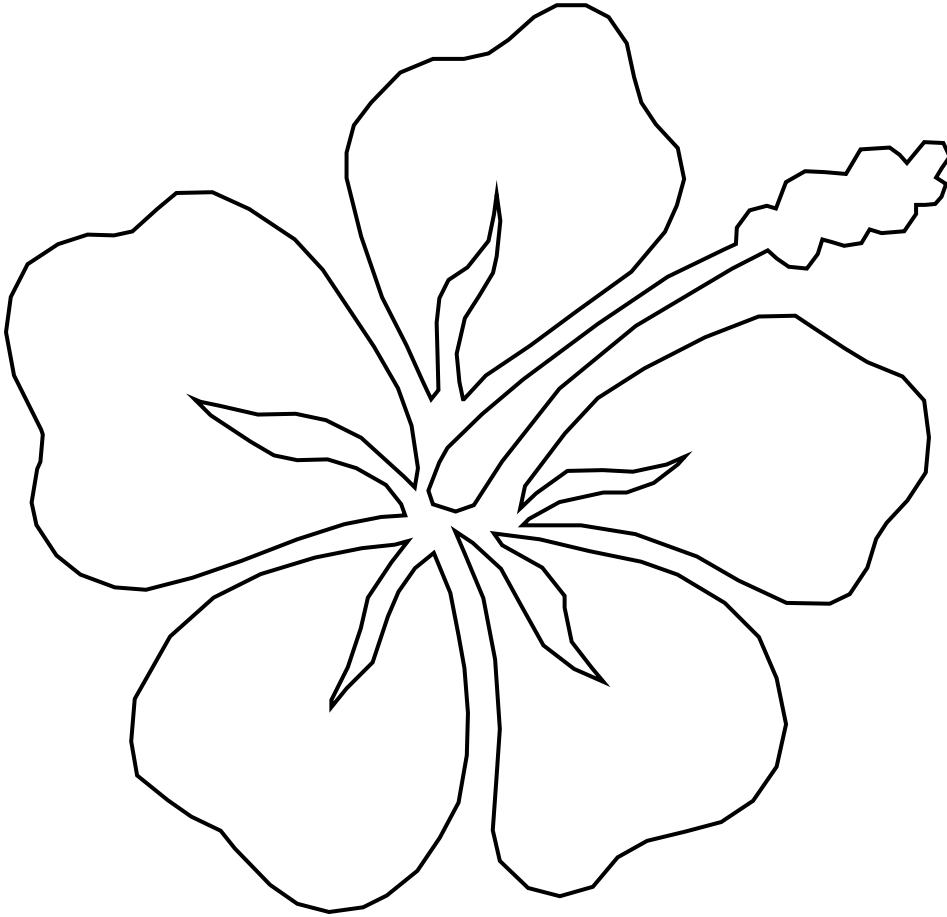


Sew the side borders onto the left and right sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the border. Then sew the top and bottom borders onto the quilt. Press seams toward the border.



Layer and quilt. Join the binding strips end to end and attach to quilt using your preferred method.
