Dimple

A Charm square friendly quilt by Kerry Glen
for The Bali Bundle Circle.



The charm squares used are 6 ½" x 6 ½"

The size of this quilt is determined by the number of charm squares you have. Each block is made up of 1 dark and 2 half light squares.

READ THROUGH CAREFULLY BEFORE CUTTING.

STEP 1

Separate your charm squares into a light set and a dark set.

STEP 2

Take 2 light squares and place right sides together fold in half lengthwise and mark. *(I use my iron to do this).*


STEP 3

Draw a line through the middle with a pen and then stitch a ¼" seam each side. *(Tip: I used my Fastpatch Seam Liner to draw the lines, quicker and more accurate).* To speed up the process I chain pieced each block.

STEP 4

Using your rotary cutter slice through on the marked line. Iron open the seam.


STEP 5



Fold the new square in half with the seam line running top to bottom. Press on the fold line this becomes a placement line.

STEP 6

Using the circle template on the back cover, trace on to template plastic or freezer paper. Place your template on the fold line and cut through both layers around the half circle.




(Tip: I used my Phillips Fiber Art Midi Cut Around tool and cut through at the 4" mark. This gave me accurate shapes and was a quicker method.)

STEP 7

Take your dark square and fold on the diagonal press this fold with your iron. This becomes a placement line for your circle.

STEP 8



Place circle on to the dark background square. Line up the seam line with a diagonal placement line and the fold line pressed in step 5.

STEP 9

Appliqué the circle on to the square. I used a blanket stitch on my machine with a variegated thread that suited all of the colours used in the charm squares.

STEP 10

Trim your square to 5 ½" x 5 ½" Now layout the squares on a design wall ensuring that similar colours are spaced apart.

STEP 11

Join the squares in rows with ¼" seam. I press seams all one way on one row and the other direction for the next row. This way the seams nest neatly.

STEP 12

Join the rows together.

STEP 13

Layer with batting and backing and finally quilt. I wanted to keep this quilt simple so stitched in the ditch and around each circle.

STEP 14

Label and enjoy.
