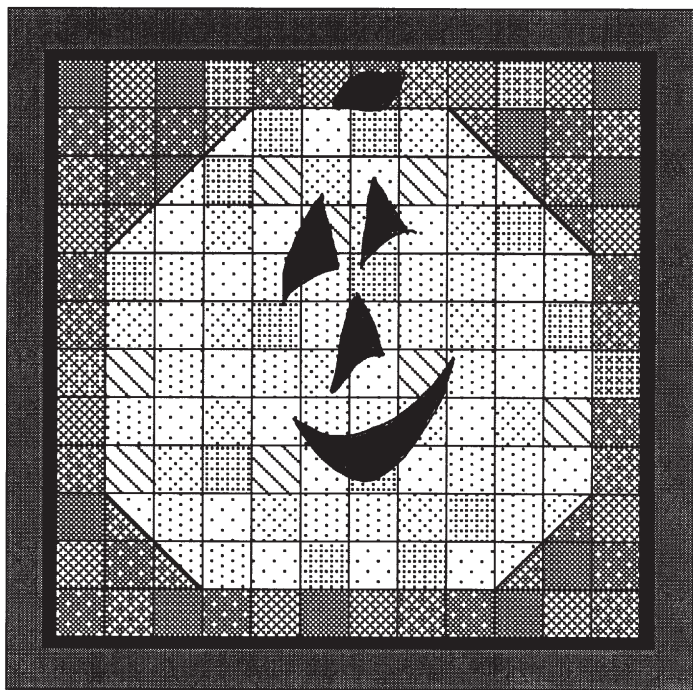


Patchwork Pumpkin Patch



Basic Patchwork Pumpkin Patch without borders is approximately 24 inches by 24 inches square.

- instructions are for one block
- all seams are 1/4 inch

Raw Materials:

- scraps of a wide variety of oranges
- scraps of a wide variety of dark blues and purples
- scraps of black or brown for the face and stem

Cut:

- 82 — 2 1/2 inch by 2 1/2 inch squares of orange
- 52 — 2 1/2 inch by 2 1/2 inch squares of blues/purples

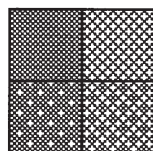
Make:

- 10 half-square triangles of orange and blue to finish at 2 inches. (If using a grid method, grid should measure 2 7/8 inch.)

Construct:

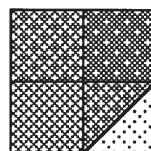
- Construct units A–H in quantities shown below

unit A



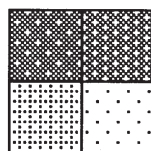

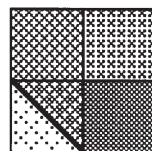

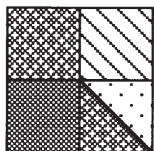

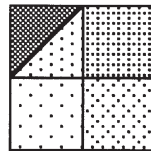

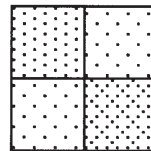

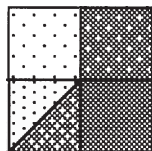

Assemble:

- Assemble units A–H as shown in basic Patchwork Pumpkin Patch diagram. Some units may need to be rotated during assembly.
- If making just one patch, add a 1/2-inch and then a 2-inch finished border in desired colors. Applique face or leave plain. Quilt and bind.
- Make four or six basic Patchwork Pumpkin Patches. Sew together, add borders, quilt and bind.
- The choice is up to you!
