Scrappy Velcro Ties Instruction



Materials: Scrap fabric, sticky back Velcro (7/8"), metal rectangle ring (optional)


1. Cut your scraps into 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " with a round edge like this



2. Stick the Hook (Spiky) end at the round edge of fabric and sew around it



3. Sew both fabric strips together leaving 1 ½" opening



- 4. To help creating a smoother round edge, trim half of the seam off around the round edge on one side and trim the other side into small triangles around the round edge (be careful not to cut too close to the thread)
- 5. Flip inside-out and sew the opening



6. If you want to be able to remove it to use for another item in the future, put the rectangle ring on the flat edge and sew the edge to secure the ring (or see step 7 for easy one-use way of sewing)



7. For and easier way to sew, just secure it to the cord of the item you want to apply on





8. Try out a few times to see where you want to stick the loop (fluffy), stick it on and sew it around to secure it





9. Voilà! You are done with another project! 💍 💍 💍
