

Trendy-N-Traditional Block #3



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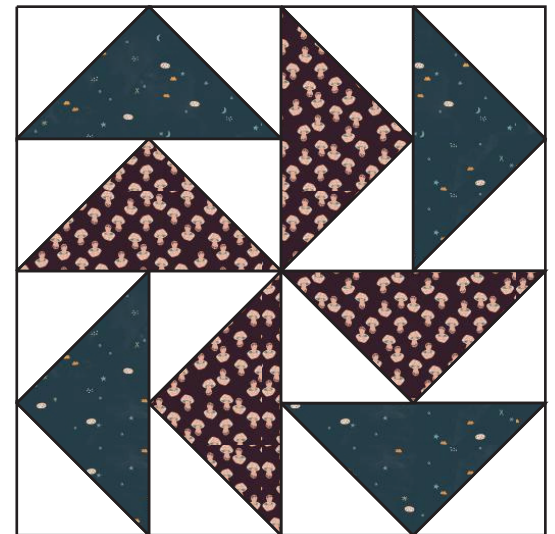
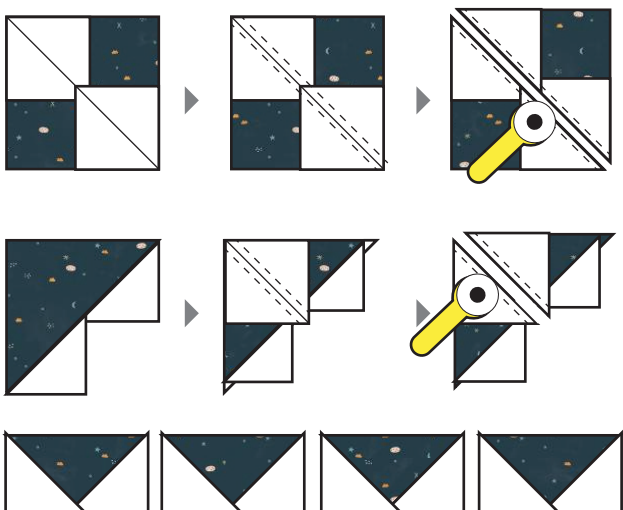
Another week of Quilting Quarantine has me longing to fly away. And so this week it's Flying Geese!

You will need 3 fabrics for this block,
1 background and 2 prints.

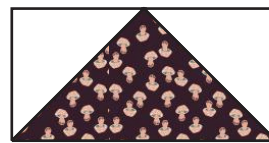
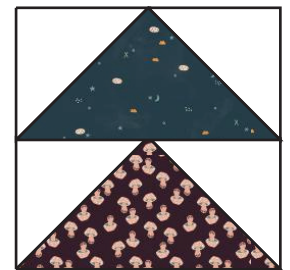
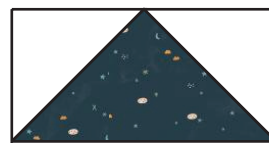
- 1 - 7 1/2" square Fabric A
- 1 - 7 1/2" square Fabric B
- 8 - 4" square background C

No Waste Flying Geese - Produces 4 blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of each light (C) square. Place 2 light (C) squares on opposite corners of the 7 1/2" (A) square.
2. Sew 1/4" from the guideline on both sides. Cut apart.
3. Press seams out. Place 1 light (C) square right side down and sew a 1/4" from the guideline on both sides. Cut apart and press seam out. Repeat with remaining unit.
4. Repeat with (C) and (B).



5. The flying geese unit should measure 6 3/4" x 3 5/8"
6. Sew sets of two contrasting flying geese together, always keeping the same print on the top.



7. Layout flying geese pairs referring to illustration above and join to complete block.

Your block should measure 13" square. This is a 12 1/2" finished block.

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
