(For horizontal, directional print add 1/4yd to Lg, for vertical (selvage to selvage) directional print fabric 1yd is enough)

Binding and Handles 3/4yd 3/4yd fat quarter

**Double-Sided Fusible Batting (Bosal's fuse II 1yd for large or medium or a 3 %" x 12" for mini. DUET II IS ALSO GOOD

Stiff Double Sided Fusible Interfacing. Use Pellon's 72F $\frac{1}{2}$ yd for large or medium, or two 3 x 5 rectangles for the mini.

Cotton Batting for Handles: about 5" or so (Use leftovers)

Screen Spine for Handles: 6 ft of .140 inch wide spline. (It's the soft plastic tubing used to repair window or door screens, available at hardware stores).

Buttons:

Totes without closure......2 lg (1 ¾") and 2 medium

You will need 12 weight cotton thread matching the binding fabric for HAND SEWING.

Other Tools. Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, sewing needles, Teflon sheet, or parchment paper, removable marker (frixion pen) or chalk, scissors both large and small, pins, wonder clips, 11 x 17 paper, rotary cutter, rulers, seam ripper, hand sewing needles size 7. Measuring tape. And your sewing machine accessories needed.
